Everyone is invited to the Honor Band Concert today at 4 p.m. in the sanctuary. Please join me in wishing them a warm Walla Walla welcome. We also welcome the many students visiting campus for March University Days. May we each sense the warmth of the Holy Spirit as together we worship God in this beautiful place.

The offertory presents several hymn tunes from Southern Harmony, the famous hymn book compiled by William Walker and published in 1835. In the anthem we hear the tune ST. COLUMBA often associated with the text *The King of Love My Shepherd Is*. You can find these words at Hymn No. 197 (and the melody at Hymn No. 639). The postlude also includes a hymn tune which you can find at Hymn No. 10, *Come, Christians, Join to Sing*.

The organ prelude, by Joseph Jongen (1873-1953), is titled *Choral*, but this is simply the word Germans often use for our Hymn. So in all of the service music we hear hymns or hymn-like music. As you prepare your heart to worship I invite you to silently meditate on the words of the hymns listed above or of those we sing.
