

Water for South Sudan delivers direct, transformative and sustainable quality-of-life service to the people of South Sudan by efficiently providing access to clean, safe water and improving hygiene and sanitation practices in areas of great need. Our commitment to help develop the new country of South Sudan includes a commitment to empowering local people and involving them as much as possible in every step of the process, from planning through implementation. WFSS is also committed to the inclusion of all people in its work and to make clean water and improved hygiene accessible to all.

Water for Sudan was established in 2003 as a not-for-profit corporation under section 501(c) 3 of the IRS code. In 2005, Water for Sudan installed its first wells in Southern Sudan. In 2011, when South Sudan gained independence, Water for Sudan changed its name to Water for South Sudan. WFSS is headquartered in Rochester, New York.

Since drilling its first well in 2005, WFSS has drilled 304 wells in remote, rural villages in South Sudan. WFSS is 100 percent privately funded, receiving no grants or funding from either the United States or South Sudanese governments. WFSS has donors in all 50 states and in 33 other countries.
