EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Interfaith Mediation Centre (IMC), established in 1995, is a non-profit, non-governmental faith based organization envisioning an inclusive society free from violent ethno-religious conflicts. The organization aims to prevent violence and promote trust and relationship building by fostering dialogue among people of different faiths and communities in Nigeria and beyond. Specifically, IMC is an organization that specializes in conflict management using the interfaith approach.

Part of the Center's goal is to achieve peaceful coexistence through interfaith cooperation and community education. The Centre has designed an early-warning mechanism that helps communities identify potentially volatile situations and provides the means to reduce tensions. The Centre also builds the capacity of its members to enhance and deepen peaceful coexistence among different faiths, to build trust and relationships among divided communities, and strengthen early warning and early response system. The center has worked in various projects including the famous project titled 'TOLERANCE' Training of Leaders on Religious and National Coexistence which is a 5 year project recently extended to February 2018.

IMC seeks to produce its success stories under this project in a series of documentaries and vox pops with focus in the focal states of Kaduna, Kano, Sokoto, Bauchi, Plateau, Borno and Imo states.

Documentary overview

The documentary will be made up of a series of 7 episodes (one episode per state). The Vox Pops will follow suit also with 7 episodes which will be shot concurrently with the documentaries.

The duration of the documentaries will be 3 minutes each while that of the vox pops will be 1 minute each. The duration for the production is from October 30 2017 to January 31 2018. All episodes are expected to be ready on or before the last day of February.
