Did You Know?

Jesus loved when the little children worshiped Him and so do we! We offer several ministries for you and your young ones during services that you can choose to take advantage of:

- **Attended Nursery** (up to 24 mo.)—Located down the children's hallway. You can drop off your child with an attendant or stay with him/her.
- **Un-Attended Nursery** (up to 24mo.) – Located at the center-back of the auditorium. You can sit with your child and listen to the service.
- **Nursing Room**— Located at the Northwest of the auditorium.
- **Training Room**— Located at the Southwest end of the auditorium.
- **Children's Bible Hour** – classes for ages 2/3 and 4yrs– 4th grade. Children can be dismissed after communion.

The Reality of Fear

Borrowed Story: The destructive effect of fear and worry on our Christian faith is vividly illustrated by Daniel DeFoe's character Robinson Crusoe. Rejecting his father's pleas, Crusoe had left home in search of wealth and adventure. His life was one of recklessness and godlessness until, following a terrible storm and shipwreck, he found himself stranded on a deserted island in the Caribbean. There his soul began to respond to the Lord, and finding a Bible among the effects salvaged from the ship, he was converted and grew into a thankful, devout, hard-working Christian. His life, though missing human companionship, was peaceful and prayerful. His faith grew strong.

But one day Crusoe found a footprint in the sand, and he suddenly realized that he was not alone on the island. Knowing the fierce, cannibalistic practices of the native tribes, he grew into a fearful man. He looked over his shoulder with every step. He no longer slept peacefully. He altered his habits and patterns. He visualized himself being captured, boiled, and devoured. He wrote the following:

Thus my fear banished all my religious hope. All that former confidence in God, which was founded upon such a wonderful experience as I had had of His goodness, now vanished, as if He that had fed me by miracle hitherto could not preserve, by His power, the provision which He had made for me by His goodness.....

Wow! That is what fear can do to us as it is diametrically opposed to our faith. Is it any wonder why one of God's many commands to His people is to "not fear?" We have spent the last three weeks working to better understand what it takes to get out of the boat and accept the Father's request to walk on water, or as we remind ourselves every week, to trust that God will see us through that which He is calling us to do. When Peter first got out of the boat in Matt. 14 he walked on water until he began to fear seeing the results of the wind on the water. His faith began to falter and he immediately started sinking into the waves. Praise God he knew at least to cry out to Jesus who in turn reached out and lifted him up.

Most of us aren't literally stepping out of our boat of life and walking on water during fierce storms, but it is pretty safe to say we face other kinds of wind. These winds can easily cause us to be fearful, lose faith, and begin to doubt God. These winds might be in the form of persecution, marital problems, financial concerns, difficulties at work, health problems, plans that fail, people letting us down, and the list goes on and on.

God's word tells us not to be afraid. We must be confident that these words are not empty, wishful thinking commands. No, they are backed by His power, character, and His love. We can live not fearing the evil around us because God is with us. He's our shepherd, meets our needs and guides our journey. He redeemed us and we belong to Him. He is our God and we are precious to Him. He promises to always be with us in the midst of life's storms and never to forsake us. We could have no better helper, and therefore do not need to fear. **(Ps. 23:4, 27:1, Is. 43:1-4, Heb. 13:5,6)**
