


## **ACCESS FOR ALL**

Access for All (A4A) taps into a young person's intrinsic passion for dance and empowers them to succeed by providing them with holistic resources that enable them to thrive through their dance education.



SINCE 2020, THE NUMBER OF STUDENT ENROLLMENTS HAS INCREASED BY 185% - FROM 48 REGISTRATIONS TO 183.

NEARLY 50% OF ALL URBANITY STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE ACCESS FOR ALL PROGRAM. OVER 80% OF CURRENT A4A STUDENTS RECEIVE FULL TUITION COVERAGE.

With the intentional focus on expanding A4A, our student body is more diverse and includes more students from predominantly Black and Hispanic neighborhoods than ever before. The average household income of our A4A families is between \$25k and \$34k. Over 40% of A4A students identify as Black, 40% as Hispanic or Latine, and 12% as Asian. 23% of A4A students reside in Dorchester and 20% reside in Roxbury.

As School enrollments return to and exceed pre-Covid levels, we will continue to see the Access for All program grow. In order to sustain this growth, additional investment in our students is required.

Each school-year enrollment can cost up to \$1,500 per student per class. We are projecting that the 2023-2024 school year will support more than 230 enrollments in the Access for All program, an investment of more than \$345,000, but we can only get there with your support.
