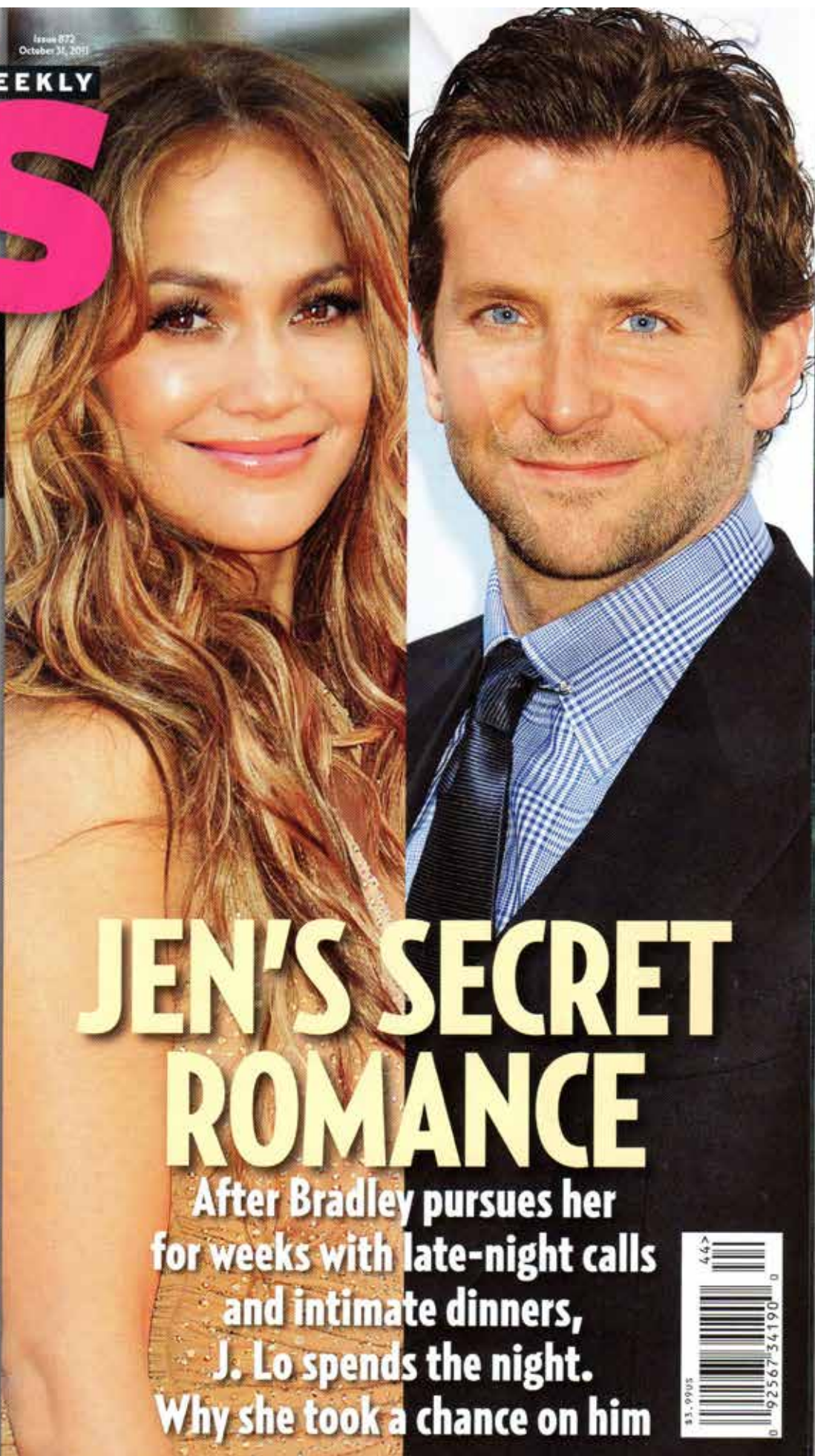

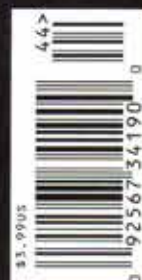

SHANNEN DOHERTY'S *Charmed Wedding!*

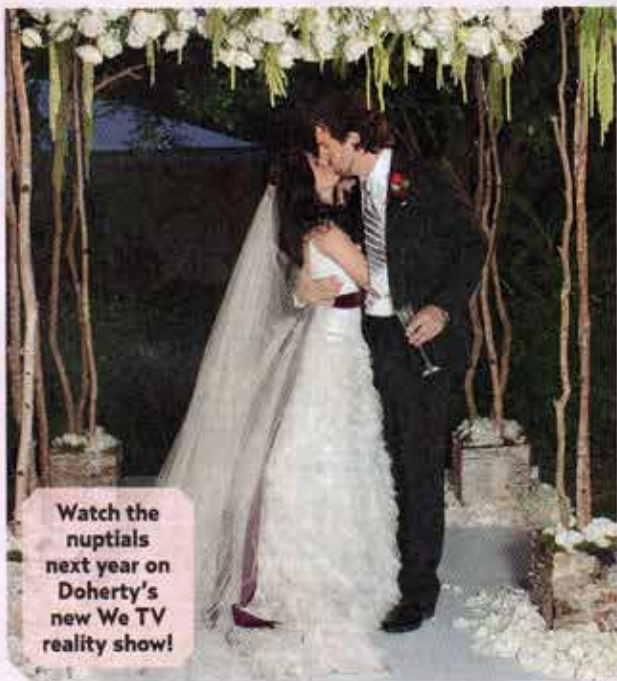
The *90210* actress says "I do!" to photographer **Kurt Iswarienko**

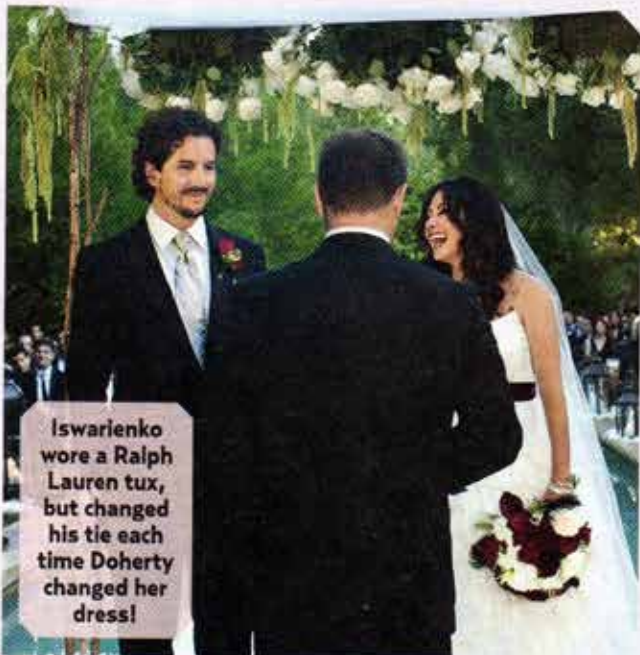
"The moment I saw it, I knew it was my dress," says Doherty of the day's first Lhuillier gown.
