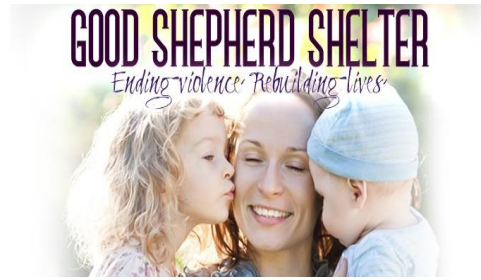


My name is Maricar and when I was 8 years old, I lived at the Good Shepherd Shelter with my mom and my 7-year-old brother. Eighteen years later, I have completed my undergraduate degree from UC Davis, graduated from law school with honor and recently passed my bar exam. I am eternally grateful to Good Shepherd Shelter.

I remember the time leading up to our stay at the Shelter. Shortly after my mom's brain surgery (for her epilepsy), my brother and I heard loud noises coming from our garage. My father was getting violent again. We could hear my dad threatening to hit my mom's newly operated head, and my mom was yelling for us to call 911. I can still remember the ringing in my ears from the sound of my brother crying. After that incident, my mom made a brave decision—leave everything to make sure my brother and I had a safe place. That safe place was the Good Shepherd Shelter. While that period in our lives was a scary time, that thought of "scary" comes second to the thought of "normal." That is exactly what the Shelter gave me—a normal childhood. What I am most grateful for is the love and support the Shelter staff gave to my mom.

It has been 18 years since my family left the Shelter. However, the Shelter never left us. They helped us find our very first apartment, furnished that apartment (Judge Tom even carried a refrigerator on his back up a flight of stairs!), connected us with the Gripp family who, for 18 years, sent us Christmas gifts, blessed me with a scholarship during my time at UC Davis, and most recently, attended my graduation ceremony from law school! Even though to the outside world, our childhood may seem grim, the Shelter gave my family hope, faith, and love; and paved the way for a happy life and a bright future.
