Additionally, our club is celebrating our 70th year with an exhibit at The Campbell House, at 482 E. Connecticut Ave, Southern Pines. The exhibit shows how the visionary ladies of the Southern Pines Garden club shaped the landscape of the community through projects, programs and initiatives. Visitors will learn the interesting history by viewing large panels featuring photographs and language that depicts the many contributions.

Our exhibit is part of The Arts Council of Moore County exhibit in The Campbell House for the month of April. It is called Palustrus: Celebrating Longleaf Through the Arts. This exhibit is part of the "Party for the Pine" a celebration on Saturday, April 21, 2018 which is a partnership of many community and state groups.

The home tour includes the following homes:

- **"Loblolly,"** at 140 N. Valley Road in Southern Pines, designed for Helen Boyd Dull, a founder of the garden club and a cousin of the Boyds of The Campbell House. Designed by famous architect Aymar Embury who is most well known for enduring contributions to NYC architecture & open spaces in the early 1900's such as The Central Park Zoo.
- **The Saulnier Home** at 880 Massachusetts Avenue in Southern Pines, a rare home designed by Alfred B. Yeomans, nationally renowned landscape architect who was instrumental in shaping

the “Weymouth” neighborhood in the late 1800’s with home and landscape design.

- **Liscombe Lodge** at 75 Linden Road in Pinehurst, which was for many years the home of George Marshall, proponent of The Marshall Plan and winner of the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize.
- **Yellowframe Farm** at 2962 Youngs Road in Southern Pines
- **The Moore Home** in CCNC
- **Ailsa House**, home of Mr. & Mrs. Carty David
