CANAPI’s mission is to empower an inclusive community through education, outreach and awareness while eliminating stigma and HIV transmission.

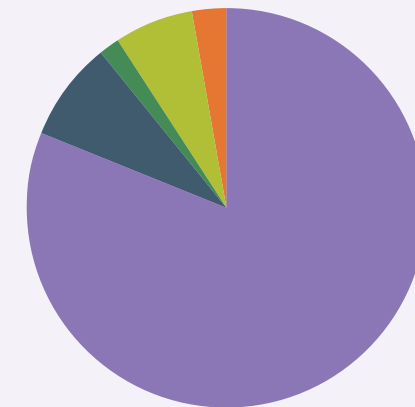
## Accomplishments

- 6,901 condoms distributed



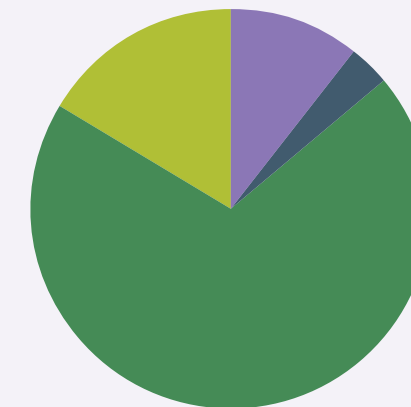
