The Development Grant provides up to \$2,000 in financial support to experienced dancers, choreographers and teachers of dance to further their education and development in dance.

Applicants are not required to demonstrate financial need but rather to select a dance program to attend that has demonstrated a standard of excellence. All applicants must detail what they expect to accomplish in the program and provide concrete details on how they will share their professional development with the Roaring Fork Valley community. This grant may be awarded each year to one applicant. Applications are due by March 15.
