SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Makers Collective allocates a portion of our donated funds toward the arts program of a school in Greenville County, SC. The goal of this program is to provide supplementary arts funding to area schools and connect them with our artists.

WHO

This scholarship is open to all schools in Greenville County (both public and private). All schools are eligible for funding without discrimination due to race, religion, socioeconomic status, etc. Applications will be posted publicly online at www.indiecraftparade.com.

WHAT

Makers Collective allocates a portion of our donated funds toward the arts program of a school in Greenville County, SC. **One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded for 2017.** Awarded funds are made available to the selected school at the start of their Spring semester. During that semester, Makers Collective directors will be in contact with the project manager at the school either by phone or in person.

The School Scholarship program was created to help inspire young artists in our schools through exposure to local art and artists.

At the completion of the school year, a **detailed written report is required** to document that funds were used in accordance with the project manager's original intentions.

HOW

Each application is reviewed by the Makers Collective Board of Directors who will determine the recipient of the funds based on the following criteria:

Educational Impact (50%)

Will this funding:

- expand an arts program that is lacking in resources
- introduce students to local artists and their work
- introduce possible career options as a professional artist
- create connections between local artists and local schools
- encourage ongoing partnerships between artists and schools
- expose students to a greater spectrum of art work than is typically available in a classroom setting

Need (30%)

Does this school demonstrate:

- need for the funds
- evidence of less than adequate resources available or a non-existent art program
- current art program/budget that is lacking

Proposed Use (20%)

Does this school show evidence:

- of a competent staff and a designated project manager to carry out the project
- that funds will be used responsibly
- of an innovative and feasible plan for using funds

WHY

We love art and craft, and we love our city. We hope this program will provide schools in Greenville County with resources that may be lacking in their current budgets, and inspire a new generation of artists.

WHEN

Applications can be submitted by mail or online and must be received before November 15, 2016.
