



SANTA MARGARITA STAKE LAUREL EXPEDITION 2016 LAUREL EXPEDITION GUIDELINES

All youth must agree to abide by these guidelines by signing the appropriate box on the Laurel Expedition Medical and Image Release Form.

1. Young Woman should plan to stay at Laurel Expedition the entire time and must stay with the group at all times. Exploration or wandering alone is not permitted.
2. Young Woman may **NOT** drive themselves to and from Laurel Expedition. Plans must be made in advance for early/late pick up/drop off.
3. Transportation to and from Laurel Expedition will be provided by ward youth leaders in their personal vehicles.
4. Strict adherence to safety and traffic rules is mandatory.
5. Young Woman should be courteous, polite, respect the property and rights of the organizations and businesses they encounter.
6. All property and equipment is to be maintained and used with respect. Any harm or destruction to any property will be the responsibility of the young woman and her parents to repair or replace.
7. Obey instructions of all adult leaders and personnel throughout Laurel Expedition.
8. Follow all dress standards as listed on "What to Wear/Bring" sheet. If you have any questions, ask your ward Young Women President.
9. Church Standards, including the Word of Wisdom and all standards of morality as listed in the For the Strength of Youth pamphlet, are to be obeyed at all times.
10. Ward/Stake Youth Leaders must be notified prior to Laurel Expedition of any physical limitations or diet restrictions that preclude youth from participating in any of the planned activities. (See Medical and Image Release).
11. Ward/Stake Youth Leaders must be notified prior to Laurel Expedition of the necessity for any medication, inhalers, etc. required by youth during Laurel Expedition.
