The Global Outreach Team is pleased to introduce to Crossroads Brady and Jess, missionaries with Team Expansion. *Brady and Jess' last name is withheld to protect themselves and their ministry.

Team Expansion is based near Louisville, Kentucky, and has been helping missionaries multiply disciples and churches among the unreached for over forty years. They work only among unreached populations. Their vision is for 24 disciple-making movements (DMM)—defined as “four streams of churches that have grown to the fourth generation”—by 2024. You can learn more about the history, passions, values, and activities of this organization, learn how many globally have never heard the gospel, and sign up for their newsletter at teamexpansion.org.

Brady and Jess live and work in a restricted area and use a code name when referring to the country in which they're located. They're currently involved in 24 hours of language study four days a week, and look to be as strategic as possible at finding people who may be open to the gospel, as well as for future leaders in the movement. Many of these connections are made in coffee shops, on prayer walks, or being introduced to friends of friends.
