Hey Crossroaders, as a Crossroads Faith Community Nurse, I just wanted to share some tips for staying safe in this "new world" we are in with COVID-19.

- Social distancing (staying six feet apart)
- Wearing a face mask or cloth face covering in public spaces
- Frequently washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds
- STAYING AT HOME IF YOU ARE FEELING ILL

Heat & Water Safety Heat is the number one weather killer in the U.S

- Always using an SPF-15 or higher sunscreen and sunglasses when outside
- Staying hydrated and drink lots of low or no-sugar beverages
- NEVER leave children or animals in a car unattended
- Always swim with a buddy in designated areas supervised by lifeguards
- Never leave a child unattended near water or trust a child's life to another child
