

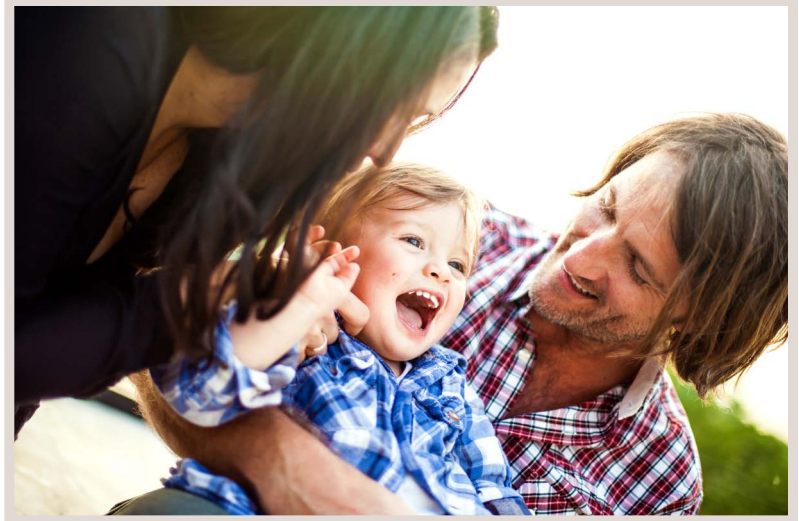
## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- Students with a concentration in Child, Adolescent and Family Studies will be prepared for professions as child life specialists, adoption caseworkers, day care center directors, counselors, elementary teachers, special education teachers, and youth services directors.
- Students will study human development over the life-span, learning counseling theories, research methods, cultural diversity, and effective teaching strategies.

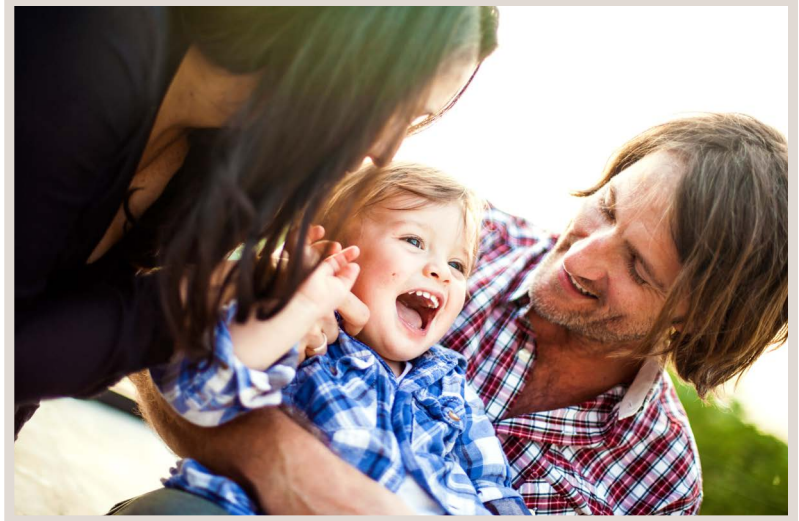
