


ABOUT THE CONGRESSIONAL HOCKEY CHALLENGE

On March 6, 2009, Congressional staff, Administration officials and lobbyists from a wide range of interests and industries left behind their day jobs to join together for a little fun on the ice to raise funds for the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club. The first game was played at Kettler Capitals Iceplex and had a crowd of around 300 attendees. The Lawmakers won a hard-fought 6-4 victory on that first afternoon, thanks to two goals by Congressman Brian Higgins of Buffalo (D-NY).

Thus was born the Congressional Hockey Challenge. All involved share a love of the game of ice hockey coupled with a desire to make it a more widely accessible sport. In a decidedly partisan town, this event brings together lawmakers and lobbyists, Republicans and Democrats, in a charity ice hockey game to raise money for worthy groups.

In 2010, the event was moved to the Fort Dupont Ice Arena and garnered the support of the National Hockey League and the Washington Capitals. Over 500 crowded the stands to watch the game, and over \$50,000 was raised for the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club and Fort Dupont Ice Arena. The Lobbyists, thanks to stellar goaltending by Andrew Emerson and Brian Regan, and a potent offense spearheaded by C2 GROUP's own Nelson Litterst (two goals) and Sean O'Neill of the Associated General Contractors of America (one goal, two assists), roared back to win 7-2.

The 2011 game was played at the Verizon Center thanks to the generosity of the Washington Capitals and the National Hockey League. The event raised over \$100,000, and the Lobbyists solidified their position as the dominant team with a dramatic 5-3 win. While one of the goals was a late empty-



netter, Bridgestone America's Christian Gullott struck the game-winning blow with a highlight-reel caliber goal, beating the powerful Lawmaker defensive pairing of Salvatore "Tory" Mazzola and Brad "Spin Doctor" Dayspring, and sneaking the puck under the pads of former Lawmaker goalie Anthony Weiner.

The event continued to grow in 2012, when the NHL and the Thurgood Marshall College Fund established a new four-year academic scholarship for participants of the NHL's Hockey is for Everyone (HIFE) initiative. The scholarship provides opportunities for qualified HIFE participants to attend any



of the country's 47 public Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCUs) or Predominately Black Institutions (PBIs). Proceeds from ticket sales and the online silent auction continue to support the Fort Dupont Ice Arena and the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club.

In 2012, the Lawmakers struck back. The potent posse of policymakers, led by two key assists from Congressman Erik Paulsen (R-MN), took advantage of a lethargic legion of Lobbyists to end the first period with a comfortable 3-1 lead. The Lobbyists began to emerge from their apparent slumber in period two and surged in the third and final period on the back of two goals by Lobbyist forward Andrew "No Dice" Mills. The final Lobbyist effort fell short, granting the Lawmakers a 5-3 victory. With both teams now tied at two wins each, the 5th Annual Congressional Hockey Challenge promises to be a thriller from start to finish. And while only one team can raise the Congressional Hockey Challenge Cup, the real winners are the first two NHL Scholarship recipients: Donald "Donnie" Shaw of Washington, DC's Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club and Ricky Lucas of the Ed Snider Youth Hockey Program in Philadelphia.

Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club and Fort Dupont Ice Arena



The home rink of the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club, the Fort Dupont Ice Arena is situated on National Park Service land and operated by Friends of Fort Dupont Ice Arena, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. The Arena is the only public indoor ice rink in the city

of Washington. The Fort Dupont Ice Arena has been named as an America's Promise "Safe Place" - a safe place for young people with structured activities during non-school hours. This designation was awarded to the Arena in December of 2001 by America's Promise, the Alliance for Youth organization founded by General Colin L. Powell. It serves as an anchor in its community and as a place of refuge for children in need



by providing skating instruction and classroom activities free of charge or at highly affordable rates.

Founded in 1978 by Neal Henderson, The Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club is an NHL-sponsored, award-winning 501(c)(3) charitable organization providing local and inner-city youth with the opportunity to participate in organized ice hockey. The Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club is the official hockey program at the Fort Dupont Ice Arena serving children of all age groups.

Participants have a wide range of experience in skating and game play, and ages range from 8 to 17. The program teaches young people discipline through athletics and coaching, and helps establish self-esteem, a sense of purpose, and offers an incentive to excel academically.

The benefits of organized sports extend far beyond the rink: the girls and boys who join the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club learn life skills. As these children grow, they will become better citizens and will learn to give respect and anticipate respect. Children participating in the Fort Dupont Ice Hockey Club have a 100 percent high school graduation rate, and over 90 percent continue to higher education.
