Getting There : Durham Station is a 35 minute walk from the Collingwood College Halls accomodation. The address and Postcode for the Collingwood College Halls is South Rd, Durham DH1 3LT. The address and Postcode for the Earth Sciences building is DH1 3LE. A useful Durham University Estate map can be found here:

Trade Stand Setup: Trade Stands will be in the second floor of the Earth Sciences Building (DH1 3LE). Parking is available but restricted and has to be agreed at the Campus Security Gate. Stand setup is from 12pm-6pm on Wednesday 12th September or from 7am Thursday 13th Sept.

Registration / Accommodation / Parking: Ensuite accommodation will be in Collingwood and Grey College (a 10-15 minute walk to the Calman Learning Centre).
