There was a ceremony at the end to give out the medals and ribbons, and everyone from the team got one. We all had fun.

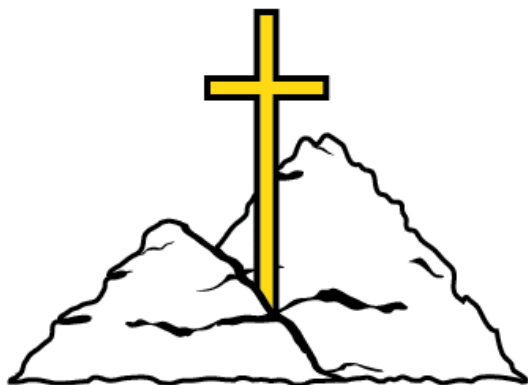
Thanks to the teachers, Mr Moore and Mrs Potter, and to our parents for supporting us throughout the gala. Thanks to all the pupils who supported us too.
