

Pisek Hall is an open meeting hall, providing foldable circular tables, chairs and a baby grand piano. The hall, with a capacity of 220 is ideal for large or small meetings, parties or social events. Currently undergoing renovations, including new lighting, air conditioning, and flooring, Pisek Hall has also been made handicap accessible.

The Jan Hus Gymnasium, located on the fifth floor for a solid warmup, is a full sized wood floor basketball court with viewing balcony. Brightly lit by east and west facing windows, the gym is used by several sports groups, including martial arts, as well as serving as a venue for parties, theatre workshops and sleeping space for our Mission Visitors!

The Masaryk Room, in use for many years by the 12 Step groups of the Upper East Side, is a beautiful, classically styled meeting room, comfortably seating fifty.

The mainstay of the original 1877 building, and designed by Czech immigrants, the Sanctuary is an open space with exquisite woodwork and a stunningly decorate Czech-designed organ. Receiving excellent morning light, the space has great acoustics and a beautiful wood design. Due to the nature of the space, only religious functions confirming with the guidelines of the Presbyterian Church USA, or the performance of fine arts events, may be conducted in this space.

The recently renovated Manse, a former residence of the pastors at Jan Hus, is an 800 sq. ft. one bedroom apartment located with the church's main structure. Falling in line with our mission of support for those in need, the Manse is only rented out for short term stays to families with relatives needing the care of NYC hospitals.

The Jan Hus Playhouse is a fully function theater, equipped with lighting and sound equipment. The audience area comfortably fits sixty, with black drapes to give an intimate experience with the performers.
