ENROLMENT SCHEME & ROLL NUMBERS

The BOT has completed its consultation with our community and neighbouring schools and will now be making a recommendation to the MOE. The BOT is still on course to have the enrolment scheme in place by the start of Term 3.

It should also be noted that:

- The enrolment scheme will not affect any student currently enrolled at Ngatea Primary School. Therefore all current students who are outside of the proposed zone will continue to be enrolled at NPS.
- The BOT is committed to keeping current families in one school. Therefore, the BOT will endeavour to enrol siblings (yet to enrol as New Entrants) of all current pupils.
- The BOT is very aware of the impact an increased roll is having on current students, learning programmes and staff. The BOT is limited to the regulations and guidelines set by the MOE guidelines.
- The BOT is putting significant resources/funds to help ease the pressure of overcrowding in the classrooms.

LINC-ED

Last Friday new updates were shared on Linc-Ed. At present when you log in through your parent account you will see your child/ren's:

- Current goals for Reading, Writing and Maths
- Learning Powers Post
- Students from years 5 - 8 have logged in, selected a Learning Power goal and written a post about it
- Assessments: Most current assessment data
- Attendance - current attendance percentages
- Finance - your school account including current balance and activities and fees paid.

We will continue to update Linc-Ed throughout the year.

Goals will be updated regularly and we will keep parents informed when updates are published.
