Hudson Yachts, Morrelli & Melvin, and HH Catamarans are pleased to announce our newest project, the HH55. In keeping with our high level of luxury and performance, this yacht is an all carbon affair. Rig, hulls, and structures all enjoy the superior safety, strength, and weight saving properties that only carbon can offer. Like its HH66 big brother, the HH55 has the curved "C" daggerboards and T Foil rudders, giving greater performance and a smoother ride in the waves. This is a very fast boat that is truly ocean ready.

The HH66 progress is sailing right along. The hull and bridgedeck moulds have been finished and the first layer of carbon has already been laid onto the outer hulls.

The moulds have exceeded our expectations in terms of quality. Quality tooling means quality boats, and we couldn't be more pleased with how they turned out. We enjoyed an eventful Saturday flipping the 60'x30' hull mould.
