

Carnival Island Cowl

Designed by Lee Gant

Finished Measurements

35" circumference by 8" wide

Note: Worked in the round in one piece

Gauge 2 stitches per inch in pattern; gauge not critical for this piece.

Materials Traditions Fiber Arts Carnival; 85 yards Size 13 (9mm) 24" length (or size to obtain gauge)

Tapestry needle Stitch Marker

Stitch Glossary YO =Yarn over Pssso = Pass the slipped stitch over K2tog = Knit 2 together

Cowl Note: Pattern repeat is a multiple of 4 + 2. If you want a larger circumference, add multiples of 4 to the cast on number...remember that will increase the amount of yarn needed to complete project.

Cast on 70 stitches, place a marker and join into a round, being careful not to twist stitches.

Round 1: *K1, YO, Slip1, k2tog, Pssso, YO; repeat from * to last 2 sts; k2. Round 2, 4, 6: Knit Round 3: K2, * YO, slip1, k2tog, Pssso, YO, k1; rep from * to end. Round 5: K2tog, YO, k1, YO, * slip 1, k2tog, Pssso, YO, k1, YO; repeat from * to last 3 sts; Slip 1, k1, Pssso, k1. Round 7: K1, k2tog, YO, k1, YO, * slip 1, k2tog, Pssso, YO, k1, YO; rep from * to last 2 sts; slip 1, k1, Pssso. Round 8: Repeat round 2.

Repeat rounds 1 – 8 until piece measures 8" (or desired length) End having completed an odd number round.

Bind off loosely in knit. Weave in any ends.
