## COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From July 1, 2014, through August 31, 2014, our office handled **134** arraignments, **87** probation revocation hearings, and **92** sentencing hearings.

## JURY TRIALS:



### COMMONWEALTH VS. JASON STRADER COMMONWEALTH VS. TAUNYA STRADER

On August 4, 2014, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of Commonwealth vs. Jason Strader and Commonwealth v. Taunya Strader. The Straders were each charged with 46 Counts of Violating Graves and Theft by Deception over \$500, 2 Counts, and Theft by Unlawful Taking over \$10,000.

This investigation began when Deputy Pam Glover was alerted that some of the bronze grave markers were being pulled up at Green Hill Memorial Gardens, a cemetery owned by the Straders. On April 27, 2013, Dep. Glover and two other deputies went to Green Hills to investigate. Jason Strader and other individuals were in the process of removing graves, and the deputies discussed this with both of the Straders. They were advised that the markers were being sold for scrap and that they would order new ones in the future.

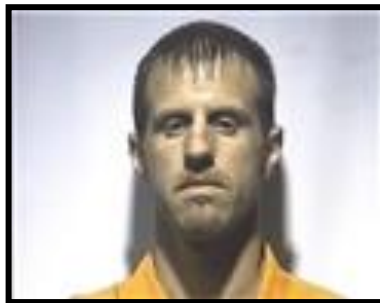
On April 23 and April 27, 2013, two loads of bronze markers and some decorative vases were sold to City Salvage for scrap metal. Jason Strader went on the first occasion and explained that he was the owner of Green Hill Memorial Gardens and had the right to sell these markers for scrap. He opened an account with City Salvage and received over \$5,000 from those first two sales. On April 29, 2013, when employees of the Straders attempted to sell the third load, it was intercepted by the Christian County Sheriff's Office and the investigation began. The findings were presented to a Christian County Grand Jury and the Straders were indicted on the above listed charges in May 2013.

At the trial, four former employees, and the former owner of Green Hill Memorial Gardens, testified about the normal operating procedure when a marker had to be repaired or replaced and that the owner of the marker or their family members would always be contacted in those situations. They further stated that new markers would be ordered prior to the removal of a damaged marker and replaced at the same time as removal. Several of the former employees were told by Jason Strader that he would only be replacing the markers if someone complained about them missing. The former groundskeeper showed pictures of some of the markers that were removed,

indicating that they could have been repaired or that they were only damaged upon removal. He also showed pictures that were taken just a few months prior to the trial showing that at least five of the markers removed had not yet been replaced, contrary to what the Straders insisted.

Jason Strader testified, claiming that he only removed them to attempt to beautify the cemetery, pursuant to his duties under the perpetual care laws and the contracts signed by the owners of the lots. He also claimed that he had replaced all of the markers that had been removed. However, several people testified that the markers that were replaced were not identical, and did not include specific things that their ancestors requested and paid for, such as military insignias. There were dozens of markers that were sold for scrap metal that were purchased pre-need, had never been placed into the ground, were not damaged, and the owners of those markers are not deceased. Strader claimed that the building they were stored in was not properly maintained or bonded, so he could not keep them there. There was no testimony that any replacements for those markers had been purchased.

After 2 hours of deliberation, the jury found the Defendants Not Guilty on all charges.



### **COMMONWEALTH VS. SIDNEY FALKNER, III**

Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Michael Cotthoff tried the case of Commonwealth vs. Falkner on August 25, 2014. Falkner failed to appear for a pretrial conference in October 2013 and was charged with one count of Bail Jumping, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree. Falkner, while on pretrial release from other charges, tested positive for drugs several days before he missed his court date. The Commonwealth alleged he intentionally missed his court date because he had violated his release conditions and knew he was going to have to return to jail.

Falkner testified that he went on a self-induced methamphetamine binge and was not in control of his actions when he missed his court date. On cross-examination, Falkner stated that he thought the Clerk's Office would mail him a new court date and that he did not know there were active arrest warrants for him. However, it was established that Falkner was arrested 3 months later in a trailer that contained drugs and an inactive methamphetamine lab. The location Falkner was arrested at was not an address the Clerks could have notified him at. Falkner also admitted to purchasing large amounts of pseudoephedrine over this 3 month period. Falkner's estranged wife testified that Falkner intentionally missed court because he did not want to go to jail. Jail calls from the wife to Falkner only days after the failure to appear established Falkner knew he was on the run.

The jury was unable to reach a unanimous verdict and a mistrial resulted. Falkner's cases were set for a pretrial conference on September 24, 2014.

## **GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:**

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider “plea-bargains” as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion. A “Pretrial Diversion” is only available to those defendants that are pleading guilty to Class D felonies [1-5 years] [DUIs shall be ineligible] and they are only allowed one diversion in any five (5) year period.

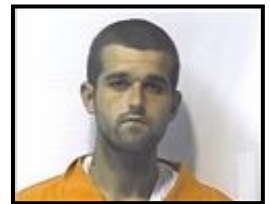
