SAFETY TIPS FROM COMMONWEALTH'S DETECTIVE KENNY OVER

Cyber-Bullying Tips

Cyber-Bullying is using the internet, cell phones, etc. to send texts, photos, rumors, threats, intended to hurt or embarrass others.

Please share and discuss these tips with your children about how to address cyber-bullying:

- Tell an adult that you trust about what is going on.
- Don't delete any of the emails, texts, etc. These can be used as evidence.
- Keep a record of any incidents.
- Don't forward or share any messages that spread rumors about yourself or others.
- Don't respond to cyber-bullying, let the authorities handle it.
- If possible, report the incident to the administrator of the website. Facebook and YouTube have safety centers to report cyber-bullying.
- Recognize that you do not have to subject yourself to cyber-bullying. Report it to a trusted adult.

GRAND JURY:

The November-December Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned **100** "True Bill" Indictments, **1** "No True Bill," and there were no cases referred to District Court. As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached.

COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From November 1, 2012, through December 31, 2012, our office handled **92** arraignments, **97** probation revocation hearings, and **100** sentencing hearings.

GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Please refer to prior newsletters for more detailed explanations of guilty pleas, Pre-Trial Diversions, and other terms. And, please keep in mind that it is ultimately up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be diverted, probated or sentenced to prison.

JURY TRIALS:



COMMONWEALTH V. DAVID HOFF

On November 1-2, 2012, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of

Commonwealth vs. David Hoff. Ken Roberts, former detective with the Christian County Sheriff's Office, investigated allegations of sexual abuse by David Hoff on his step-daughter and his biological daughter. On March 2, 2009, Hoff was tried and convicted of three counts of First-Degree Rape involving his mentally disabled step-daughter, which resulted in three children being born to the two of them. Hoff received three 15 year sentences, to run consecutively for a total of 45 years. On February 8, 2010, Hoff was tried and convicted of eight counts of First-Degree Rape and eight counts of First-Degree Incest involving the oldest of the children born to him and his step-daughter. The jury in that case sentenced Hoff to ten Life sentences, in addition to 60 years.

In January 2012, the Supreme Court of Kentucky remanded Hoff's case involving the eight counts of Rape and Incest for a new trial. On November 1 and 2, 2012, the Commonwealth re-tried that case and the jury found him not guilty. Therefore, David Hoff remains incarcerated on the original forty-five year sentence and will be classified as a sex offender for the rest of his life.

On November 29-30, 2012, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of

Commonwealth vs. Seth Wallen. Wallen was charged with Murder for shooting and killing Corey "Ike" Trice on October 9, 2010.

Witnesses told police about a truck and white male they saw in the area just moments prior to Trice's shooting, and they stated that the truck left the area immediately after the shots were fired. Police located the truck and Wallen at his residence two days later. Wallen admitted to police that he had previously purchased marijuana from Trice and had confronted Trice about being 'shorted' and receiving marijuana of a low quality. Before confronting Trice in person, Wallen picked up a 'burner' gun and went to meet Trice near his mother's home. Trice allegedly refused to return any of Wallen's money, and this angered Wallen. Wallen then pulled out the gun, shot Trice two times and drove away. He took the gun back to the person he obtained it from and that was the basis for the Tampering with Physical Evidence charge, since police were never able to locate the weapon.

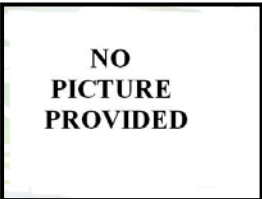
While Wallen tried to claim self-defense, the jurors were not convinced and found Wallen guilty of Murder and Tampering with Physical Evidence, selecting a sentence of 25 years. He is scheduled for a formal sentencing hearing with Judge Atkins on February 12, 2013.
