Safety Tips for Holiday Decorating

- Keep matches, lighters, and candles out of the reach of children.
- Keep candles away from drapes and other decorations.
- Supervise children when carving pumpkins.

- Do not use electric lights on metallic trees, a frayed wire can electrify the entire tree.
- Do not overload extension cords, no more than three standard light sets per single extension cord.

- If small children are present, avoid decorations with small parts or trimmings that resemble candy or food.

Drug house auction nets funds for local law enforcement

Jail can be a great way to keep someone from repeatedly breaking the law, in Commonwealth Attorney Lynn Pryor's opinion.

When multiple lock-ups don't do the trick, law enforcement can resort to other measures.

"If putting them in jail is not teaching them the lesson, then we're going to start taking their stuff," Pryor said.

The Hopkinsville Police Department, in conjunction with Pryor's office, did just that in the case of Derryl Blane. Blane, who is serving 35 years in prison on various drug charges, was convicted of continuing to sell drugs from a home on East 17th Street.

After three raids at the property and six separate drug purchases made there by undercover officers, Pryor said it was easy to establish the house as having a perpetual drug presence. With this information, Pryor was able to get an order from a judge allowing for the auction of the property.

At the auction this Monday, the house sold for a little more than \$10,000.

Although Pryor said she thought the value was around \$18,000, she was not disappointed with the sum because it is generally very difficult to get a house to auction.

In fact, this was a first for her office, she said. Generally when someone is arrested at a similar location, the house is either rented or in the name of someone else, Pryor said, which can make it difficult to prove the homeowner knew about the illegal activity taking place at the residence.

HPD will receive 85 percent of the proceeds to "assist with drug enforcement efforts," according to a news release from the department.

Pryor said her office will receive the other 15 percent, and use it for things that have been under-funded, like training and equipment.

Pryor hopes the sale sends a message to "serious dealers" in the community: Whether it's a car, home or property, Pryor said her office will pursue confiscation of property in drug cases.

GRAND JURY:

The July-August Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned **82** "True Bill" Indictments, **3** "No True Bills," and **1** case was referred to District Court. As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached.

COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From July 1, 2011, through August 31, 2011, our office handled arraignments, probation revocation hearings, and sentencing hearings.

GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider “plea-bargains” as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion. This is only available for Defendants who have no recent felony convictions and allows a defendant to have the charges dismissed if they complete all the terms and conditions of their diversion, such as payment of restitution or completion of drug rehabilitation.
