The overall experience for this Grand Jury was educational and positive. The expectations of the Grand Jury as well as the procedures for meeting those expectations were clearly explained. The members of the Commonwealth's Attorney's office were diligent in answering our questions and helping us better understand certain areas of the law and legal process.

We suggest for future Grand Jury selection there be a sufficient number of alternates chosen along with the selected Grand Jurors. This would likely improve the efficiency of the Grand Jury process.

We were pleased to learn that within her short time in office, the Commonwealth's Attorney has started to dynamically address one main area of concern, flagrant non-support. Those involved with flagrant non-support cases are working collaboratively to improve the process and outcomes of these cases.

This Grand Jury would like to reiterate the previous Grand Jury's comments about our law enforcement officers. These officers appearing before us were obviously dedicated to making our community a safer place to live and raise our families.

We appreciate this opportunity to serve our community. And would like to thank all of those involved in the legal process for working to make our community a safer place.
