GRAND JURY:

The November-December Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned **91** “True Bill” Indictments, **2** “No True Bills,” and there were no cases referred to District Court. As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached under the Grand Jury tab.

COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From November 1, 2014, through December 31, 2014, our office handled **128** arraignments, **89** probation revocation hearings, and **107** sentencing hearings.

COMMONWEALTH VS. MICHAEL KOROLEVICH

On December 1, 2014, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of Commonwealth vs. Michael Korolevich. Korolevich was charged with Murder.

The defendant, Michael D. Korolevich, had requested a bench trial in which there is no jury and the judge hears the evidence and issues the verdict. Korolevich was accused of murder on allegations he shot his wife in the head in 2011 and tried to make it look like a suicide.

Judge Self found Korolevich guilty of 2nd Degree Manslaughter. In explaining his decision, Self said he does not believe Korolevich meant to kill his wife, but that doesn't erase his disregard for her life.

The Defendant is scheduled for final sentencing on March 4, 2015.

GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider "plea-bargains" as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion. A "Pretrial Diversion" is only available to those defendants that are pleading guilty to Class D felonies [1-5 years] [DUIs shall be ineligible] and they are only allowed one diversion in any five (5) year period.
