**GRAND JURY:**

The November-December Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned **76** “True Bill” Indictments, **2** “No True Bills,” and there were **2** cases “referred to District Court”. ## JURY TRIALS:



### COMMONWEALTH VS. CHRIS MILLER

On November 2-3, 2015, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Katherine Foster tried the case of Commonwealth v. Chris Miller. Miller was charged with Trafficking in a Controlled Substance, 1<sup>st</sup> degree, 1<sup>st</sup> offense, Methamphetamine while Armed, two counts of Wanton Endangerment, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia while Armed.

This case began on January 24, 2014, when officers were serving a warrant of arrest on Miller at his residence. During the execution of the arrest warrant, officers noticed items in plain view in the residence warranting the need of a search warrant. During the search of the residence, Detective Sears and Special Agent Schaub located methamphetamine, scales, syringes, .380 gun, and .40 caliber ammunition. Detective Sears interviewed Miller, who took ownership of the items seized. Both Detective Sears and Special Agent Schaub testified on behalf of the Commonwealth.

Additionally, Officer Choate from the Princeton Police Department testified that he had occasion to investigate Miller in an unrelated matter, and during a search of his car found .380 ammunition and a receipt showing that the ammunition was purchased from Walmart in Princeton. Morgan O'Boyle, the Walmart manager, verified for the jury that the receipt found in Miller's car was from his store. He also played surveillance from the store showing Miller purchasing the ammunition. In relation to the methamphetamine, Annie Smith from the Kentucky State Police Western lab testified that the substance found in the Miller residence was in fact methamphetamine.

After twenty minutes of deliberation, the Jury found the Defendant Guilty on Possession of a Controlled Substance, two counts of Wanton Endangerment, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The Defendant will be formally sentenced on March 9, 2015.



### COMMONWEALTH V. NATASHA HOBSON

The case of Commonwealth v. Natasha Hobson was tried by Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Adam Turner on November 16, 2015. Hobson was indicted for Theft by Deception over \$500.

The Commonwealth's case rested on the testimony of one witness, the victim in the case, Cindy Daugherty. Ms. Daugherty stated that on or around January 10, 2014, she was approached by Hobson and her husband to screen print some items of clothing. Ms. Daugherty operated a screen printing business, Monograms and More, and Hobson wanted Ms. Daugherty to print jerseys, shirt, and other items for an

upcoming exhibition basketball game for the Tri City Hoyas. Ms. Hobson and her husband were involved with organizing the event.

After missing an appointment, Hobson came into Ms. Daugherty's business where it was discussed what services were to be provided and at what cost. An agreement was reached, and due to short notice, Ms. Daugherty incurred extra costs in expediting order that she did not pass on to Hobson.

Once the items were finished, Hobson met Ms. Daugherty to retrieve the items and pay Ms. Daugherty. Hobson looked over the goods and was pleased with them. She then wrote Ms. Daugherty two checks; one for \$600.00 and one for \$1,320.00. These checks both were returned due to insufficient funds.

Ms. Daugherty contacted Hobson to advise her of the bad checks. Hobson told Ms. Daugherty she expected the checks to bounce because others she had hired for various services for the game had to be paid. Hobson also stated that the items she had ordered from Ms. Daugherty had not sold that well and that too many were ordered in the first place. Evidence was also presented that at the time Hobson wrote the \$1,920.00 total in checks to Ms. Daugherty, there was only \$.18 in the account.

According to Ms. Daugherty, Hobson promised to make good on the payment. Eventually, in February, Hobson presented a \$600.00 cashier's check to Ms. Daugherty to satisfy one of the checks. Although she promised to make good on the rest of the payment, she never paid Ms. Daugherty the remainder of what was owed, but instead tried to ship the remaining clothing back to Ms. Daugherty who refused to accept it.

Hobson testified that she never looked at the items when payment was exchanged, but that when she did, the work was unsatisfactory. No photos or work orders were available to confirm or contradict her testimony regarding what was ordered and what was received. She also stated that the \$600.00 payment was paid, because it was for items ordered that were for a third party, the Hopkinsville Police Department, which agreed to make good on the payment despite any defects. No testimony was offered to support this other than Hobson's own testimony.

After Ms. Daugherty and Hobson testified, the case was handed over to a jury for deliberation. The jury acquitted Hobson of the charge of Theft by Deception over \$500.00.



### **COMMONWEALTH VS. BRANDON SMITH**

On November 30, 2015, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor began the trial against Brandon Smith for the Murder of Keon Grant that occurred on May 14, 2014. The jury heard evidence from a number of people who were at the home at 713 First Street on that evening when Keon Grant arrived. There had been a recent dispute between Smith and Grant, although they had been friends for years. Witnesses each testified about the events, according to their perspective at that time. Keon's friend, Vic Mills, went with him that evening and testified about seeing Brandon Smith point a gun in Keon's face. Vic told Keon to run, which he did, and then shots were heard. Only one person said that they saw Brandon chasing Keon down First Street, and the weapon used to shoot him twice in the back was never located. After deliberating for some time, the jury was unable to reach a unanimous verdict and a mistrial was declared. The trial has been rescheduled for September 19, 2016.

## **GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:**

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider “plea-bargains” as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion. A “Pretrial Diversion” is only available to those defendants that are pleading guilty to Class D felonies [1-5 years] [DUIs shall be ineligible] and they are only allowed one diversion in any five (5) year period.

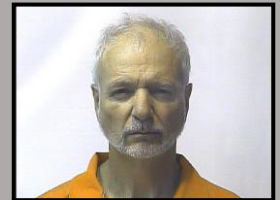

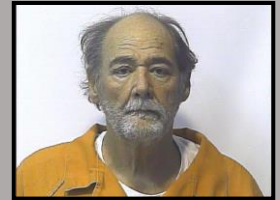

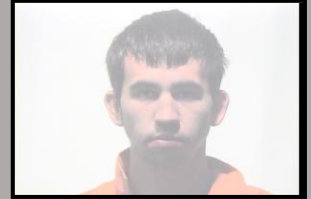
