GRAND JURY:

The September-October Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned **108** "True Bill" Indictments, **5** "No True Bills," and there was **1** case "referred to District Court". As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached under the Grand Jury tab on our website.

COMMONWEALTH VS. BRUCE CALDWELL

On September 12, 2016, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Katherine Foster tried the case of Commonwealth v. Bruce Caldwell. Caldwell was charged with Sexual Abuse, 1st degree.

At trial, the minor victim testified that the Defendant, who was a close friend of the family, sexually assaulted her one evening at his apartment when he was babysitting her and her younger siblings. She told the jury that she confided in her parents later that day and told them about the assault.

Detective Sears from the Hopkinsville Police Department testified that he conducted a forensic interview with the victim at the Pennyrile Children's Advocacy Center and sought a warrant of arrest for the Defendant. Lastly, the victim's father testified about a phone conversation that he had with the Defendant wherein the Defendant apologized to him when confronted about the sexual abuse; the Defendant said he "messed up".

After approximately an hour of deliberation, the jury returned a verdict of Guilty. The jury recommended a three year sentence, and he was formally sentenced on November 2, 2016 by Judge Andrew Self.



COMMONWEALTH VS. QUINTON QUARLES

On September 19, 2016, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor began the trial in the case of Commonwealth vs. Quinton Quarles. Quarles was charged and found guilty of the murder of Keith Ivory on McHenry Street. The trial ended on September 22, 2016 when the jury took approximately

two hours to find Sills guilty of Murder and another hour to set his punishment at 30 years in the Kentucky Department of Corrections.

The jury heard from several people who were present at an apartment where they were gambling on McHenry Street on November 22, 2014. Quarles and Ivory had a verbal altercation that was split up when they started shoving and wrestling with each other. Quarles was seen leaving the rear of the apartment, going to his car, returning with a gun in his hand, pointing it at Ivory and then following Ivory out the front door of the apartment. Once they were outside, Quarles pointed the gun directly in Ivory's face and shot him one time. After fleeing the scene, Quarles used his cell phone to search the internet on how to remove gunshot residue from your hands. Quarles was formally sentenced by Judge Atkins on November 14, 2016.

Andrew Self Lynn Pryor Christian County Sheriff's Office On October 10 – October 24, 2016, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of Commonwealth vs. Travis Orten. Orten was charged with the murders of Kendra Lee and Jacob Ort, as well as the assaults of William Miles and Michael Forrester, from an incident that occurred on Huffman's Mill Road on July 4, 2015.

In the early morning hours of July 4, 2015, Orten was at his home with Brandi Cooper and Curtis Killebrew. Cooper said that Killebrew picked her up and took her to Orten's residence where they used methamphetamine and engaged in sexual activity. At some point, Cooper contacted her friends Ort, Miles and Forrester to come to Orten's. There is some dispute as to whether she asked them to bring more methamphetamine, but she knew that they were coming there to obtain money. When they arrived, there was an altercation between one of the males and Orten. Orten fled to his neighbor's house and asked him to call 911. When the truck that had arrived at Orten's residence left, Travis Orten got in his Yukon Denali and chased them down Huffman's Mill Road.

The Event Data Recorder from Orten's SUV indicated that he was travelling at 103 mph just 2.5 seconds prior to colliding with the truck. He did slow down to approximately 90 mph a half a second prior to the collision, but the truck was still sent into a ditch where it flipped and ejected the three passengers. The driver was pinned inside the truck where he remained until EMS arrived. Jacob Ort was pronounced dead at the scene after he struck a tree head first, and Kendra Lee survived for approximately one week following the collision, though she never regained consciousness.

The jury found declined to find Travis Orten guilty of murder or manslaughter, but instead found him guilty of 2 counts of Reckless Homicide and 2 counts of 4th degree assault. Even after hearing of his criminal history, they could not reach a decision on whether Orten was guilty of being a 1st Degree Persistent Felony Offender or to what term of years he should be sentenced. Given the available range of punishment of 10 to 20 years, the parties reached an agreement that Orten would serve fifteen (15) years in the Kentucky Department of Corrections. Orten will be formally sentenced on January 4, 2017. He is also facing a probation revocation on that date for prior felony convictions.

COMMONWEALTH VS. ADAM STANRIDGE

On October 27, 2016, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Katherine Foster tried the case of Commonwealth v. Adam Standridge. Standridge was charged with Sodomy 1st degree, Victim under the Age of Twelve.

At trial, the mother of the victim testified that the Defendant, who is the victim's father, had a visitation with the victim at the Defendant's residence in Oak Grove, Kentucky a few years earlier. She stated that one day in 2015, the victim advised her that the Defendant committed an act of sodomy with him while in the living room of the Defendant's residence. The mother told the jury that she contacted her local police department in Texas as well as the Oak Grove Police Department and filed a report. A forensic interview was then conducted at a Children's Advocacy Center in Texas.

The victim testified next, and he told the jury about the act of sodomy that was committed at the hands of his father, the Defendant. He described the location of the offense, what his father told him to do to him, and how it made him feel. The victim also described for the jury drawings that he had drawn during his forensic interview of the living room, their positions, and the act of sodomy.

Lastly, Chief Assistant Lynch from the Oak Grove Police Department explained to the jury the reason that the case was transferred from Texas to Oak Grove and the steps that were taken in the investigation. For the defense, the Defendant and his wife testified. The Defendant denied committing any act of sexual abuse. His wife testified about the vindictive nature of the victim's mother and how she unnecessarily calls child protective services on the Defendant. Standridge was found not guilty.

GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider "plea-bargains" as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion. A "Pretrial Diversion" is only available to those defendants that are pleading guilty to Class D felonies [1-5 years] [DUIs shall be ineligible] and they are only allowed one diversion in any five (5) year period.
