GRAND JURY:

The March-April Grand Jury returned **106** "True Bill" Indictments, **1** "No True Bills," and there were **5** cases "referred to District Court". As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached under the Grand Jury tab on our website.

COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From March 1, 2017, through April 30, 2017, our office handled **169** arraignments, **129** probation revocation hearings, and **141** sentencing hearings.

COMMONWEALTH VS. WILLIE SLAPPY

On March 9, 2017, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Maggie Gigandet tried the case of Commonwealth v. Willie Slappy. Slappy was charged with four counts of Burglary, 3rd Degree and was charged with being a Persistent Felony Offender in the First-Degree. One of the counts of Burglary, 3rd Degree was based on an allegation that, during the early morning hours of July 7, 2016, Slappy bashed in the front door of 41A Discount Smokes and Lotto and stole multiple cartons of cigarettes from the store. The other 3 counts of Burglary, 3rd Degree were based on allegations that Slappy entered the Wal-Mart in Hopkinsville and stole two 32 inch Vizio televisions on July 7, 2016 and on July 8, 2016, and stole a 40 inch television on July 11, 2016. Before these dates, Slappy had already been given a trespass warning from Wal-Mart prohibiting him from entering Wal-Mart property again.

Kayla Shearl was an employee of 41A Discount Smokes and Lotto and testified that she closed the store on the night of July 6. In the early morning hours of July 7, 2016, she was called about the break-in and came to the store. She testified about the damage to the front door and the missing cigarette cartons. She also testified about the store's surveillance system and showed the jury the video clips that recorded the break-in. She recognized the man in the video as someone who had been in the store before, and she recognized the tennis shoes the man in the video wore.

Sophie Williams was also an employee of 41A Discount Smokes and Lotto. She testified that she watched the surveillance videos that recorded the break-in, and she immediately recognized the man in the video as "Slappy." She recognized him because he had been in the store a few times as a customer, and she had seen him in her neighborhood.

Steven Draper was an Asset Protection Associate at Wal-Mart and testified about the surveillance system in Wal-Mart. He showed the jury the surveillance videos that recorded a man entering Wal-Mart and stealing a television on July 7, July 8, and July 11, 2016. The videos showed the man from the time he walked into Wal-Mart until the time he left with the televisions, and Draper pointed out to the jury that on these three occasions the man used a tool from another department in the store to both successfully remove and attempt to remove the security wire from the television boxes before leaving with them.

Jamie Smith was an Asset Protection Manager at another Wal-Mart. She testified about the trespass warning that Slappy had already been given at her store on March 7, 2016. She explained that this warning informed Slappy that he was not welcome on any Wal-Mart property in the nation, and if he did enter Wal-Mart property, Slappy could be charged with criminal trespassing. Detective Travis Shown of the Hopkinsville Police Department explained his investigation to the jury. He testified that he watched the surveillance videos from 41A Discount Smokes and Lotto and Wal-Mart, and he recognized the man in the videos as Willie Slappy.

The jury found Slappy guilty of Burglary, 3rd Degree for the break-in of 41A Discount Smokes and Lotto and not guilty of the three counts of Burglary, 3rd Degree for stealing televisions from Wal-Mart. In the sentencing phase, Slappy testified on his own behalf. The jury also heard evidence of Slappy's extensive criminal history. The jury found him guilty of being a Persistent Felony Offender in the First- Degree, and they sentenced him to the maximum penalty of 20 years.



COMMONWEALTH VS. GREGORY GILL

On March 20, 2017, the Commonwealth presented the case of the Commonwealth vs. Gregory Gill on the charge of Promoting Gambling in the First Degree. Mr. Gill was accused of operating an illegal gambling operation out of the Hoptown Cyber Cafe on Canton Drive in Hopkinsville. The Commonwealth's lead witness, Detective

Joseph Garcia of the Hopkinsville Police Department, testified on behalf of the Commonwealth along with Sgt. Charles Nichols and Detective Jason Sears. Each officer testified about his observations of illegal gaming within Mr. Gill's establishment.

On March 21, 2017, the Defendant presented his witnesses to the jury. At the conclusion of the proof and of closing arguments by the attorneys, the jury found the defendant, Gregory Gill, guilty of Promoting Gambling in the First Degree.

Following the guilty verdict, the Defendant entered a guilty plea to a sentence of five years in the state penitentiary. However, by agreement of the parties, this sentence was probated on the condition that the Defendant not operate any gambling related establishment in the state of Kentucky.

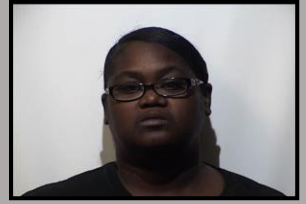
