GRAND JURY:

The May-June Grand Jury returned **110** “True Bill” Indictments, **4** “No True Bills,” and there was **1** case “referred to District Court”. As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated and hard-working, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached under the Grand Jury tab on our website.

COMMONWEALTH VS. COURTNEY BLAKEMORE

On June 27, 2017, Assistant Commonwealth’s Attorney Maggie Gigandet tried the case of Commonwealth v. Courtney Blakemore. Blakemore was charged with one count of Burglary, 2nd Degree, based on an allegation that she kicked open the door to the home of Lavenia Pollard and attacked her.

Ms. Pollard testified and demonstrated to the jury how Blakemore attacked her in her home. She testified that she had to hit Blakemore with a pot to stop the attack, and after the attack, Blakemore went to her vehicle and got a knife. She also testified about Blakemore’s previous visits to her home, her repeated statements to Blakemore to not return to her home, and prior communications between them. Ms. Pollard used to date Garnett Poole, but they no longer dated. Blakemore dated Mr. Poole after Ms. Pollard’s and Mr. Poole’s relationship ended, and Blakemore’s visits and communications were focused on their past relationship.

Ms. Pollard’s son, Ja-Ron Pollard, witnessed Blakemore’s attack on his mother and testified at the trial also. He was twelve years old at the time of the attack. He testified that he did not have a knife during Blakemore’s attack on his mother, but he moved his fishing knife after the attack was over. Mr. Poole testified that Blakemore came to his house in the hours before her attack on Ms. Pollard. Blakemore slashed his tires, and she threatened Ms. Pollard. Mr. Poole also saw Blakemore with two knives.

Officer Samantha Moore of the Hopkinsville Police Department testified by recorded deposition about her involvement in this investigation on the night of the attack. The jury saw video from Officer’s Moore’s body camera of her conversations with Blakemore. In these conversations, Blakemore denied having a knife. While she alleged that someone in Ms. Pollard’s house had a knife she did not specify which person had the knife. She repeatedly stated that she did not know how she got a cut on her finger. She also denied ever entering Ms. Pollard’s home, but after she heard that there may be video surveillance footage of the event, Blakemore stated that she was pulled inside by Ms. Pollard.

Officer Jeremy Davidson was the lead officer on the case, and he testified about the investigation into this attack. He testified that he arrested Blakemore, and he discussed his decision to arrest which included the inconsistencies in Blakemore’s story. Captain Davy Burd of the Christian County Jail testified about how calls made by inmates at the Christian County Jail are kept, and he played a call made by Blakemore after she was arrested. One of the statements Blakemore made was that she beat [her] up.

Captain Erik Pacheco testified that on May 10, 2017 Blakemore came to the police department and filled out a statement sheet. In this statement, for the first time, she named Ja-Ron Pollard as the person who had the knife and stated he cut her. She did not state on the night of the investigation that Ja-Ron Pollard had a knife, and her statement that he cut her contradicted her multiple statements on the night of the attack that she did not know how she cut her finger. Ebony Gargas testified for Blakemore and described her observations of the event. She stated that Blakemore did not go inside of Ms. Pollard's home.

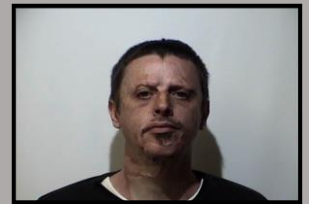
The jury found Blakemore not guilty of Burglary, 2nd Degree.
