SPOTLIGHT: SEPTEMBER IS NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has declared September to be National Preparedness Month and encourages every citizen to **“Get a Kit ~ Make a Plan ~ Be Informed”**.

- **Get a Kit:** Gather items to support your family for at least 72 hours. Your kit should include food, water (1 gal/person/day), first aid

supplies, flashlight, radio, batteries, personal hygiene items, and more. Try to make your basic kit items portable in case you must evacuate in a hurry.

- **Make a Plan:** Talk with your family about what you would do in all major threats to our area. Remember to establish two family meeting places – one near your home and one outside your neighborhood in case you are away from home during the emergency and can't return. Also establish an out-of-town contact as a common check point for all family members. Conduct family drills whenever possible.
- **Be Informed:** Be aware of what is happening in your area and stay informed of any threats. Waiting until the storm hits leaves no time for preparation!

***Internet Safety Pledge*
for Children**

- I will not give out personal information such as my address, telephone number(s), parent's or guardians' work address/telephone number(s), and the name and location of my school without the permission of my parent or guardian.
- I will tell an adult right away if I come across or receive any information that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- I will always follow the rules of Internet sites, including those rules that are based on age of use, parental approval and knowledge, and public laws.
- I will never agree to get together with someone I "meet" online without first checking with my parents or guardians. If my parents or guardian agree to a meeting, I will arrange it in a public place and bring a parent or guardian along.
- I will never send a person my picture or anything else without first checking with my parent or guardian.
- I will talk with my parent or guardian so that we can set up rules for going online. We will decide on the time of day that I can be online, the length of time that I can be online, and appropriate areas for me to visit. I will not access other areas or break these rules without their permission.

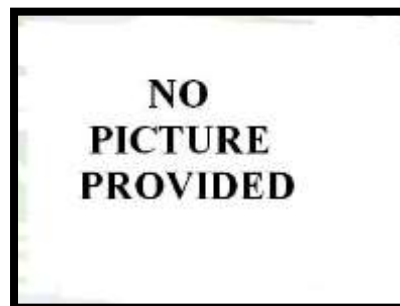
GRAND JURY:

The July-August Grand Jury effectively and proficiently returned 86 "True Bill" Indictments, 1 "No True Bills," and 3 cases were referred to District Court. As always, the Grand Jury was very dedicated, and we appreciate their service to our community. Their report is attached.

COURT PROCEEDINGS:

From July 1, 2010, through August 30, 2010, our office handled 78 arraignments, 90 probation revocation hearings, and 109 sentencings.

COMMONWEALTH V. J. WESLEY LYNN

On July 13th through July 23rd, 2010, the case of Commonwealth of Kentucky vs. Jerald Wesley Lynn was tried by Lynn Pryor and Kathi Adams before a jury in Hopkins Circuit Court on July 13, 2010, on Rape 1st Degree, Sodomy 1st Degree, and Sexual Abuse 1st Degree. Ms. Pryor and Ms. Adams served as Special Prosecutors in the case. The Defendant was a Magistrate in Hopkins County and an employee of Trover Clinic in Madisonville. Witnesses for the Commonwealth included two victims, and Detective Josh Mitchell from the Madisonville Police Department. Defendant was working as an EMT and an EKG Technician at Trover Clinic when he allegedly fondled the victims' breasts. In addition to the fondling, one witness alleged that Lynn raped her in a bathroom, and the other claimed that he forced her to perform oral sex on him. Inadmissible to the jury was that Defendant had previously been suspended by Trover for similar conduct, and there were several other victims making similar allegations in a separate indictment (currently set for pretrial conference). The jury returned a verdict of not guilty on all counts. The Defendant is no longer employed by Trover Clinic, and is no longer serving as Magistrate. Jerald Wesley Lynn's other felony case is set for a pretrial conference on 10/18/10.



COMMONWEALTH V. DEDRICK WILLINGHAM

On August 9, 2010, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of Commonwealth v. Dedrick Willingham. Willingham was charged with 5 counts of 1st degree Robbery, Fleeing or Evading Police, Tampering with Physical Evidence, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and Resisting Arrest.

On the night of August 8, 2009, Willingham dressed in all black, with a black bandana over his face, and carried a loaded rifle throughout the area of Whitney Place and Poplar Street with the intent to rob people. He first encountered Robert Jones who was outside smoking a turkey. Willingham pointed the rifle at him from behind his fence and said that he would shoot Jones if he didn't hand over all of his money. Mr. Jones was able to get inside his residence before Willingham could get over the fence. Even though a rifle and threats were used to attempt a theft, the jury found Willingham not guilty on this robbery charge as nothing was stolen from Mr. Jones.

Willingham then came into contact with Jeffrey Wilson, stealing his keys, wallet and agenda book. Wilson did not appear to testify at the trial, so the jury found Willingham not guilty of this robbery. Willingham then approached Keisha James, Deneisha James, and Tamisha Edwards who had just parked to attend a party on Whitney Place. Willingham pointed the loaded rifle at them, demanding that they hand over all their money, cell phones and purses or he would blow their heads off. All three handed over their purses and money, but Keisha James kept her cell phone which she used to call the police.

Willingham was not located that night, but much of the stolen property was recovered in the area, along with a black baseball cap. The cap was later tested and contained DNA that matched Dedrick Willingham. The following day, HPD received information that a black male was walking down the road in the area of Kirkman Square with a black bandana over his face and a rifle over his shoulder. Officers were able to locate Willingham who took off running, dropping his pants, a pair of shorts, his shoes and the rifle before being apprehended a short distance away.

The jury found Keeler guilty of only 3 of the 5 counts of 1st degree Robbery, 1st degree Fleeing or Evading Police, Tampering with Physical Evidence, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and Resisting Arrest. The jury recommended a 10 year sentence for Willingham, and he will be formally sentenced on September 22, 2010, by Judge Andrew Self.



COMMONWEALTH V. PAUL DAY

On August 19-20, 2010, Commonwealth's Attorney Lynn Pryor tried the case of Commonwealth v. Paul Day. Day was accused of Kidnapping, 1st degree Robbery, 1st degree Burglary, 2 counts of Unlawful Access to a Computer, and Tampering with Evidence.

On November 13, 2008, Roger Becker was going to work at PACS in the early morning hours when he was approached by Paul Day who was pointing a handgun at him demanding that he put his hands up and turn around. Mr. Becker did so, and Day put the gun in his back making him walk to an abandoned house on 11th Street where he tied him up. After learning that Mr. Becker had no cash, Day then demanded his credit cards and PIN numbers. Day threatened to come back and kill him if the PIN numbers didn't work.

After Day had withdrawn \$400 from the ATM at BB&T and \$600 from the ATM at US Bank, he was attempting to make another \$200 withdrawal from US Bank when the police arrived. They found the victim's credit card in the ATM and the receipts from each transaction on the ground. The handgun was located nearby as well. After hearing from Roger Becker, several officers and a Forensic Scientist, the jury found Day guilty of all charges. However, they declined to find him guilty of being a Persistent Felony Offender, despite his prior felony convictions. They ran the sentences on all the charges concurrently for a total of 15 years, and he will be formally sentenced on October 6, 2010 by Judge Andrew Self.

GUILTY PLEAS/SENTENCINGS:

This section of our Newsletter includes a brief description of sentencing hearings that took place during the previous two-month period. While many consider "plea-bargains" as a negative way to resolve cases, defendants typically plead guilty to the same charges they are indicted for. When the defendant is sentenced following a guilty plea, they stand convicted of the charges just as if a jury had found them guilty. Therefore, the only thing they bargain away is their right to a jury trial and right to appeal. You will also see the jail-intake photos of these Defendants, when available.

Once the Commonwealth makes an offer and the Defendant enters a guilty plea, it is up to the Circuit Judge to determine if the Defendant will be probated or sentenced to prison. Another option that the judge has is one that must be agreed upon by the Defendant and by the Commonwealth – Pretrial Diversion.

Pretrial Diversion: Kentucky Revised Statutes allow for a person to be placed on a "Pretrial Diversion" under certain circumstances. 1) All charges which they are pleading guilty must be Class D felonies (1-5 years); 2) The person must enter a plea of guilty, or a plea pursuant to *North Carolina v. Alford* before becoming eligible for pretrial diversion; 3) Persons ineligible for probation, parole or conditional discharge under KRS 532.045 shall be ineligible; 4) a person convicted of a Class D felony for which early release is disallowed by statute including KRS 189A.010(8) and KRS 189A.120(2) [DUIs] shall be ineligible 5) No person shall be eligible for this program more than once in any five (5) year period. A person who is placed on diversion is considered a convicted felon during the period of their diversion and is subject to the same conditions as someone who is on felony probation. If someone completes that period of diversion/probation without any infractions or new charges, they can move the court to have their case dismissed/diverted, and they are no longer a convicted felon.

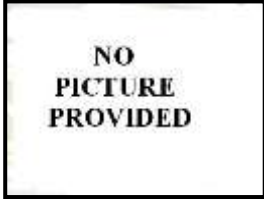
