Agrees that prior to participating the participant and/or parent or guardian (if under 18), will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if the participant and/or, parent or guardian, believes anything is unsafe, they will immediately advise the supervisor of the HC tournament or other tournament officials of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
2. Acknowledges and fully understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result from not only from their action, inaction, or negligence, but the action, inaction, or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises of any equipment used. Further, the participant, and/or parent or guardian acknowledges that there may be other risks not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
