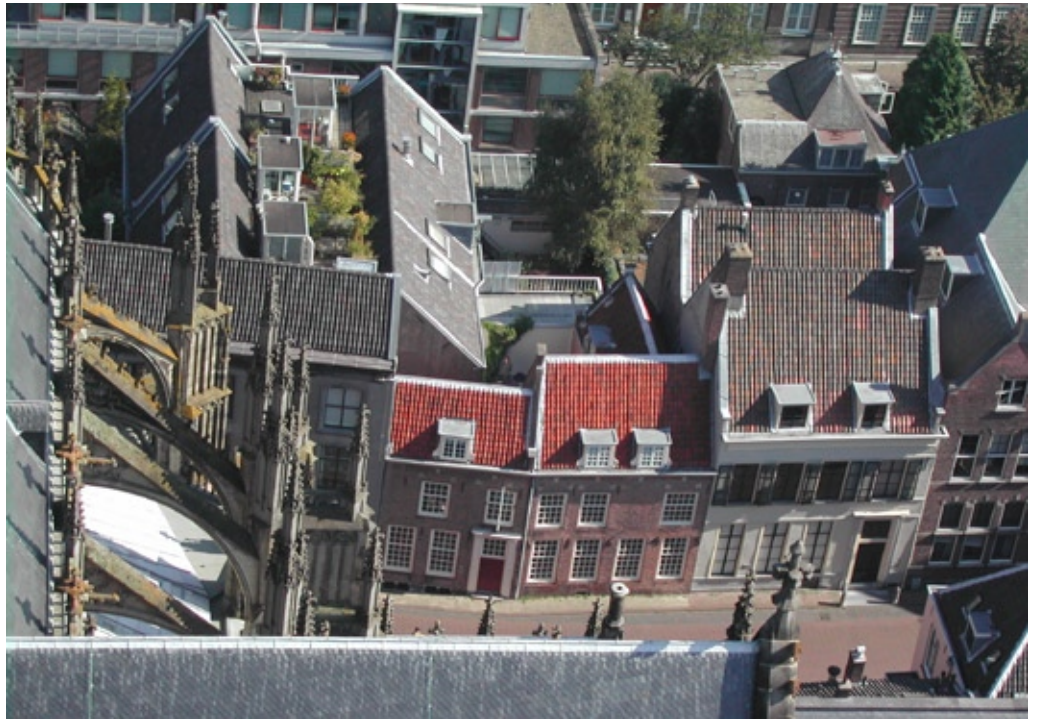


GLASS TERRACE UTRECHT

In the heart of the city of Utrecht, just behind the Dom Church, two houses from the 17th century were combined into a single private house. A small courtyard behind the houses provides the only outer space. The new steal-glass terrace is totally transparent, its light metallic color reflecting light into the work spaces on the ground floor. In the new floor made out of old bricks, small lights have been randomly placed. From the ground floor, during the evening and night, the reflection of these lights in the glass floor looks like little stars. The walls of the courtyard have been painted bright white, which gives the space an interior feeling. From the glass terrace the top of the 112 m high Dom Church tower is just visible.

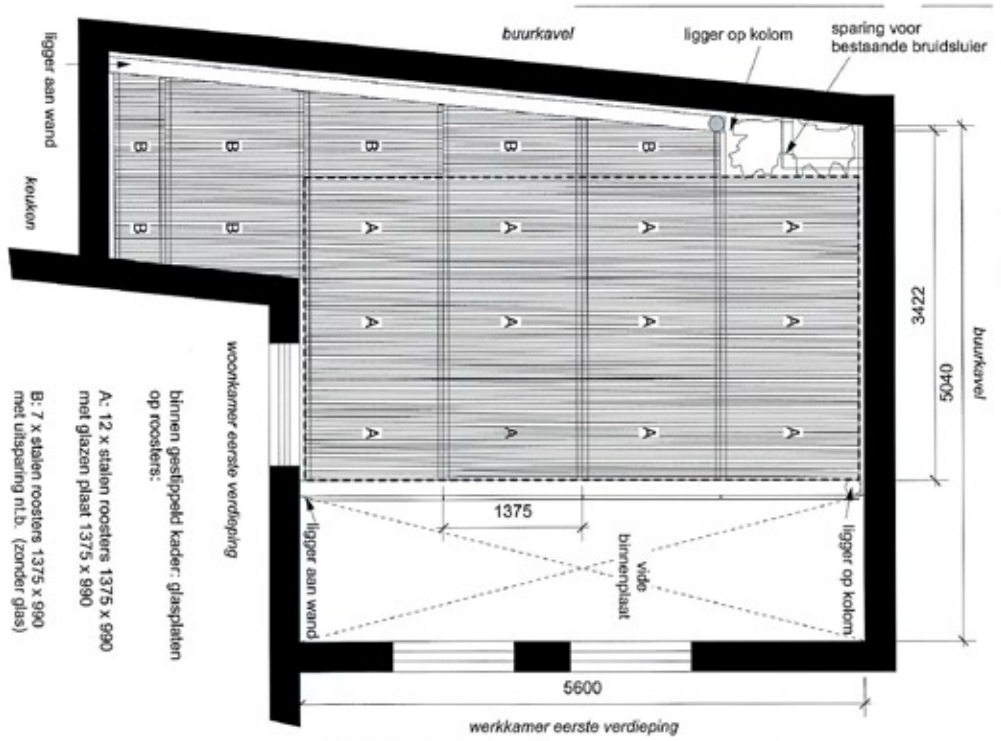
01 Bird's eye view from church tower 02 Courtyard 03 Floor plan 04 Ground floor 05 Terrace
