Mountain Ranges of the Matanuska- Susitna Valley



The Matanuska-Susitna Valley offers a unique landscape. It was originally carved out by a glacier which has long since receded, leaving a glacier silt-enriched soil ideal for agriculture and a valley that is surrounded by two distinct mountain ranges.: the Talkeetna Range, to the North of town and the Chugach Range, which skirts along the South and East edges of Palmer, Alaska.
