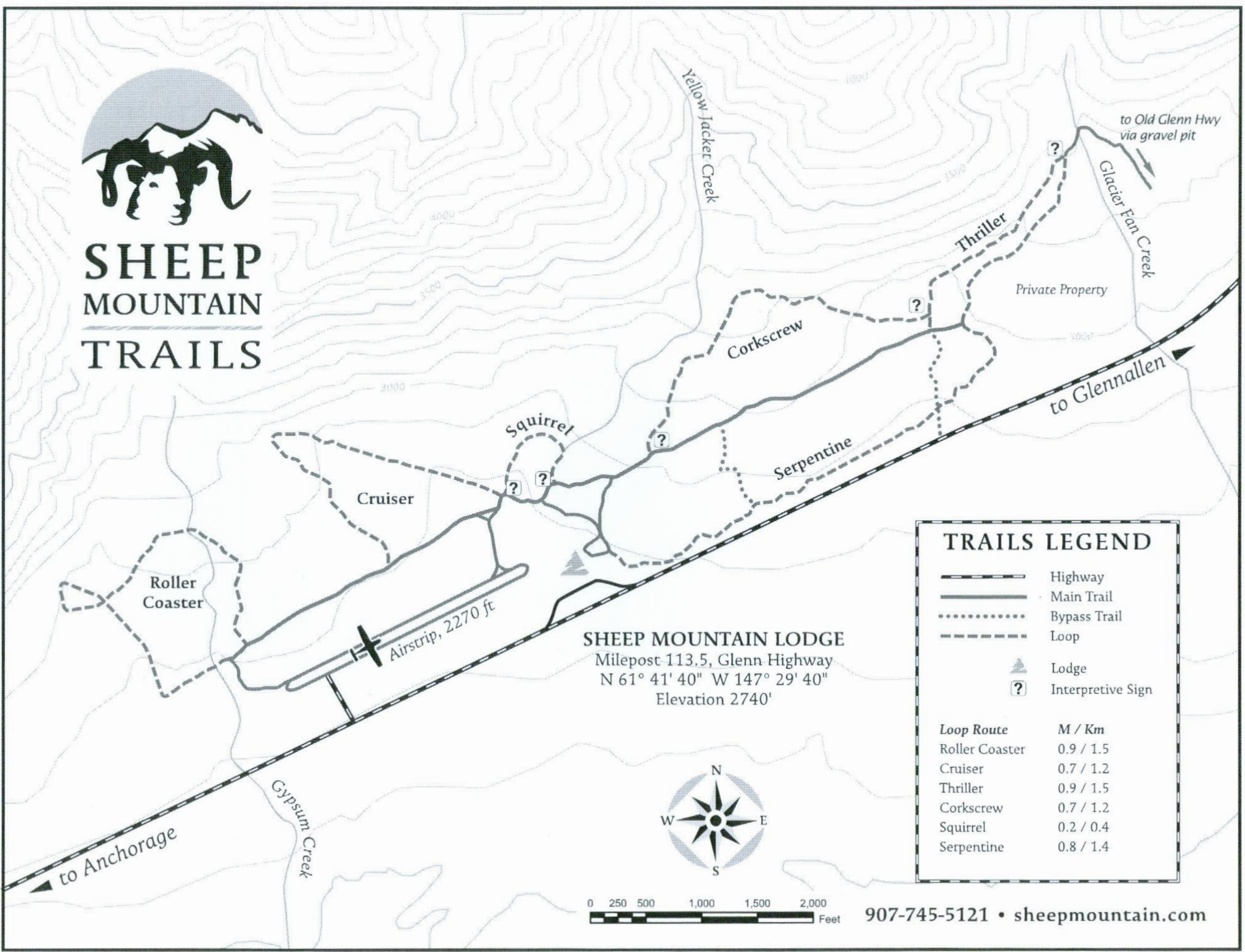

Welcome to the Sheep Mountain Lodge trail system! The trails you are using are public trails maintained by local residents and the Sheep Mountain Lodge staff. From the lodge you can find excellent hiking, mountain biking, berry picking, cross country skiing, and rock hounding opportunities.

Please note that the Sheep Mountains are a designated Dall sheep and mountain goat preserve area. Hunting of these species is not allowed in the area.

As you are enjoying the trails, please be aware that other wild animals, including moose and bear, exist within the Sheep Mountain area. Use caution when encountering any wild animal, especially cow moose with calves. Large animals are best seen from a safe distance, so remember to make some noise as you hike; a surprised animal is a dangerous one.
