**Delta Tau Delta**  
**IFC Judicial Committee Outcome**  
*Tuesday April 21, 2015*

At an IFC Judicial Committee hearing on Friday April 3, 2015, Delta Tau Delta was found responsible for the following policy violations:

*IFC Risk Management Policy:*

**III. Illegal Drugs or Controlled Substances**

- A. The possession, sale, use, distribution or manufacturing of any illegal drugs or controlled substances is prohibited

**VIII. Event Registration**

- A. All events must be registered with the IFC according to the rules outlined in the FSILG Social Event Policy. As of this writing, the Social Policy requires that events must be registered by 3pm on the Thursday before the event is scheduled to take place (events on Thursday must be registered by 3pm on the preceding Thursday). The Social Policy's requirements shall supersede the requirements listed here.

***Procedures for Events with Alcohol***

**III. Control of Alcohol**

- D. No hard alcohol can be present at any event.

*FSILG Social Events Policy:*

**Section 1:**

1. Prior to registering and hosting a social event, an FSILG shall:
  - a. Have a complete current student membership roster, as defined by the FSILG Office, on file with the FSILG Office and the relevant student governing council.
  - b. Have the contact information for the FSILG leadership, as defined by the FSILG Office, on file with the FSILG Office and their governing council.
  - c. Have a complete FSILG house resident roster, as defined by the FSILG Office, on file with the FSILG office and the relevant student governing council.

As a result of this finding, the hearing review board determined the following to be appropriate sanctioning taking in regard the specific events of the incident and Delta Tau Delta's actions:

- 1) The President and Risk Manager of Delta Tau Delta must review Delta Tau Delta's formal risk management policy with the Assistant Director of FSILGs and the IFC Risk Manager.



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- a. A finalized draft of the reviewed document must be submitted to the IFC Judicial Committee Chairman with the written approval of the Assistant Director of FSILGs by May 1, 2015.
  - b. The approved document must then be presented to the active members of Delta Tau Delta, for which 90% of all active members and the IFC Risk Manager must be in attendance.
    - i. This presentation must occur and an accurate attendance sheet must be submitted to the IFC Judicial Committee Chairman by May 14, 2015.
- 2) Delta Tau Delta must produce an agenda for a retreat of chapter officers and alumni advisors with the purpose of continuing your improvements in house leadership development and ethical decision making.
- a. A finalized draft of the agenda must be submitted to the IFC Judicial Committee Chairman with the written approval of the Assistant Director of FSILGs and the Director of Student Citizenship by May 1, 2015.
    - i. The Judicial Committee Hearing Review Board recommends that this agenda include a presentation from an employed professional of the Division of Student Life or the FSILG Office.
  - b. This retreat must occur and an accurate attendance sheet must be submitted (along with the slides from any presentations given) to the IFC Judicial Committee Chairman by October 1, 2015.

Delta Tau Delta accepted responsibility for several charges, and demonstrated a positive trend in ethical leadership since the incident in question. In the sanctions that were applied, the review board hoped to foster the continuation of these developments.
