**Nu Delta**  
**IFC Judicial Committee Outcome**  
*Monday, August 31, 2015*

During an administrative resolution meeting held between the IFC Judicial Committee Chairman, IFC Risk Manager, and the Nu Delta President and VP, Nu Delta admitted to violating the following policies:

*IFC 2015 Recruitment Rules*

**Article III Pre-Orientation:**

1. No freshmen are allowed in any fraternity house during the Pre-Orientation period.
2. No fraternity recruitment 'Event' can be held during the Pre-Orientation Period. Activities encompassed by an 'Event' are defined in the 'Definitions' section of the IFC Rush Rules. This includes, but is not limited to, a fraternity paying for a freshman and taking freshmen off campus.
3. All Chapters and their members must comply with all other current MIT rules, as well as rules created by MIT affiliated programs. 'MIT affiliated programs' include but are not limited to FPOP, ASA, and Varsity Sports.
6. No person associated with a fraternity shall be near alcohol being served to freshman.

*Risk Management Policy*

**Section VIII:**

A. All events must be registered with the IFC according to the rules outlined in the FSILG Social Event Policy. As of this writing, the Social Policy requires that events must be registered by 3pm on the Thursday before the event is scheduled to take place (events on Thursday must be registered by 3pm on the preceding Thursday). The Social Policy's requirements shall supersede the requirements listed here.

This was in response to an unregistered we event held at the Nu Delta house at which multiple incoming freshman were present. The conditions that were agreed upon were closely related to those recommended in Article III section 4 of the IFC 2015 Recruitment Rules:

1. Nu Delta shall hold no Jaunts the Sunday following the Greek Griller, but may hold events on their own property
2. Nu Delta shall pay a fine of \$1,000 to the IFC by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015
