**IFC Judicial Committee Outcome**  
*Saturday November 21, 2015*

At an IFC Judicial Committee hearing on Friday November 20, 2015, Phi Beta Epsilon was found not responsible for the following policy violations:

MIT FSILG Social Event Policy

*III. Social Event Gathering Provisions*

A. Roof Decks

Roof Decks may not be used for any social events without written approval of the Associate Dean/Director of the FSILG Office.

In its ruling, the Review Board considered the statements and RFI response of Phi Beta Epsilon, the original anonymous complaint, and both video and photographic evidence. The board found Phi Beta Epsilon not responsible for the violation. The Review Board determined that Phi Beta Epsilon provided video evidence that was far more compelling than the anonymous testimony, which did not contain supporting evidence. No sanctioning is necessary. This concludes any judicial action with regards to this incident.
