**Delta Psi**  
**IFC Judicial Committee Outcome**  
*Tuesday August 23, 2016*

At an IFC Judicial Committee hearing on May 2, 2016, Delta Psi accepted responsibility for the following policy violations:

*MIT Mind and Handbook*

**II. Policies Regarding Student Behavior**

(20). Property Damage and Destruction

Malicious or unauthorized conduct that attempts to, actually does, or is reasonably likely to damage, deface, or destroy Institute property or property belonging to another is prohibited.

As a result of this finding, the review board determined the following to be appropriate sanctioning taking in regard the specific events of the incident and Delta Psi's actions to prevent the incident from happening again:

1. Delta Psi must submit the plan for its new fall retreat to the FSILG office for review and have it approved by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. This must occur before Delta Psi can hold its next retreat. This plan must also include the location of this year's retreat, which may not be Mount Ann Park.
2. Delta Psi must draft a letter of apology to the trustees of Mount Ann Park and have it approved by a member of the FSILG office by May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
  - a. This letter should include a plan to make amends for the littering.
  - b. By May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Delta Psi must reach out to the trustees of Mount Ann Park with the letter and copy the FSILG office on the email.
  - c. Final approval for the plan to commence is required by both the trustees and a member of the FSILG office. If final approval is made, this plan must be executed by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

The Judicial Committee Hearing Review Board appreciated Delta Psi's accepting responsibility for the violation of the *MIT Mind and Handbook*. In the sanctions applied, the Review Board sought to ensure efforts were made to make reparations and to prevent the incident from occurring again.
