



## **Athletic Informed Consent Form**

Pointe Schools provides elementary school students with the opportunity to participate on extra-curricular athletic teams.

These sports require students to be in good physical shape and condition. Students are expected to participate in strenuous activities that demand physical strength and endurance.

While participating in an extra-curricular sport, the risk of injury is high, and students injuries could result in broken bones, partial or total paralysis, or even death.

Because of the possibility of serious or catastrophic injury or death and the risks involved, students must have a parent or guardian consent to their participation on an extra-curricular athletic team.

By signing below, students and parents/guardians release Pointe Schools' employees, the Pointe Schools' Executive School Council, and the Governing Board of Pointe Educational Services from any claim of negligence and from any liability arising from claims for damages for injury to our son/daughter and any claims for loss of or damage to his/her property which may arise out of his/her participation on an extra-curricular athletic team.
