- Recipient be young person between the ages of 18 and 30

- Applicants must complete the application form and short-answer questions.
- School transcripts. (The International Culinary Center requires a high school diploma or G.E.D.)
- Applicants must attach two professional letters of reference, including contact information so the referring party can be contacted. Applicants are welcome to submit additional personal recommendations as well.
- Applicants must have at least one year of restaurant experience in order to qualify for the MiNO scholarship.
- We require applicants to familiarize themselves with the International Culinary Center prior to interview. Applicants may apply to the International Culinary Center prior to application to the MiNO scholarship, but are not required to complete the application until after the selection process is complete.
