Enrichment:

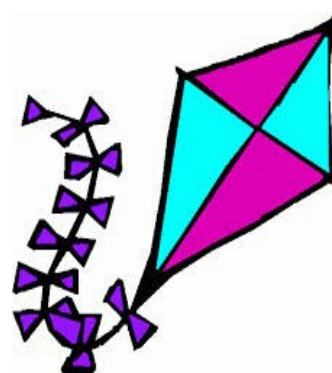
