RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. You may only show media for which you have been juried, so ensure your photos cover all the work you would like to exhibit. You may submit more than 3 images if desired.
2. All pieces on display or for sale must be ORIGINAL works created by the artist/artisan. Prints/reproductions must be labeled as such and may not be hung as part of the original work. The Board has the option of requesting removal of work that does not comply with the exhibition conditions.
3. All artists/artisans are responsible for their own insurance, including liability.
4. Exhibitors will provide any backdrops/easels/shelving/additional tables for displaying work, aside from the one provided by the community centre. Backdrops may not be more than 8' high. All exhibitors are responsible for handling their own artwork and display materials.
5. SET UP may begin Saturday at 9 a.m., at which time your site location will be available. Your booth must remain intact until 4 p.m. that day. The community centre must be cleared by 6 p.m. Saturday afternoon.
6. Refunds for cancellations will not be given after November 1, 2017.
7. Admission to the event is free to the public.
8. Smoking is not permitted in the centre.
9. All exhibitors should advertise the show via social media and their personal email list for best attendance.
