Membership Quarters

Spring: March 1st - May 31st

Fall: September 1st - November 30th

Summer: June 1st - August 31st

Winter: December 1st - February 28th

Initial Dues Payment

At the time of application, membership dues may be paid by cash, check or credit card (Visa, MasterCard or Discover). If you choose to pay by cash or check, you must pay the entire year's dues at the time of application. If you choose to pay by credit card, you have two options: 1) choose the Annual Fees option and pay for the entire year's dues, or 2) choose the Quarterly Fees option and pay today for the current quarter, with subsequent quarterly fees automatically charged to your credit card ten days prior to the start of each quarter. All memberships automatically renew and are billed on the 15th of the month prior to the anniversary month.

Subsequent Dues Payment

Memberships run continuously until cancelled in writing by either party. Memberships are not transferable.

If you provide a credit card on file, your subsequent membership dues may be paid annually or quarterly. If you do not provide a credit card on file you will be invoiced each year for your annual dues. Please indicate your choice on the Membership Application. Quarterly payments require a credit card on file that is charged automatically the first of March, June, September and December.

Payment Requirements and Finance Charges

We require payments at the time of use and in advance to register for classes. We cannot maintain house charges and invoice for payment other than annual membership renewals. You are welcome to put a credit card on file for your payments, card information is maintained by a leading, secure service, and you can track all of your charges on our website. You may also put a balance on your account to cover fees. As of February 1st outstanding balances 30 days past due will be assessed a monthly finance fee of 1.5% and program participation may be suspended. Accounts 60 days past due will be submitted for collections and membership privileges will be revoked.

Cancellation

To cancel your membership, GMTC must receive written notification no later than two weeks before the next membership quarter begins. Failure to notify GMTC will result in continuing membership fees for which you will be billed accordingly.

Reinstatement Fees

As a courtesy to our first-time members we do not charge an initiation fee. However, members who cancel and then rejoin within a twelve month period will be charged a \$50.00 reinstatement fee* (\$25.00 for Junior/Collegiate memberships).

*Reinstatement fees do not apply to memberships cancelled because of relocation.

Changes in Membership

Upgrades or downgrades of membership may be made in writing to GMTC no later than two weeks before the start of the upcoming quarter. Failure to provide written notification will result in continuation of your current membership status and all associated dues.

Suspension due to medical reasons

Individual and Junior Memberships may be temporarily suspended for medical reasons only. GMTC must receive written notification with medical documentation attached. Suspensions cannot be made retroactive, and do not apply to Family or Senior Couple Memberships. September-May Hours of Operation (Summer hours are posted prior to each summer season)

GMTC reserves the right to close early on holidays or due to inclement weather. Additionally, if more than one hour has passed from the time of the last court reservation, and there are less than three reservations scheduled for the upcoming hour, the center may close early. However, players will be notified and given the opportunity to change their reservation at no charge.

Court Reservation and Check-In Procedures

Members must allow ample time to check-in and pay applicable fees at the Welcome Center before proceeding to the court. Payment for seasonal court time, leagues, clinics, lessons, nursery, and pro shop purchases may be made by cash, check or credit card (VISA, MasterCard or Discover). Members may keep credit card information on file with GMTC for payment convenience. A charge of \$25.00 will be added to a member's account for any check that is returned to GMTC due to insufficient funds.

Appropriate Attire Required

Members must wear proper tennis attire (no cutoffs, tank tops, sports bra's etc.). Shoes that leave black marks on the court (especially basketball, jogging and cross trainers) are not permitted. For your safety, court shoes designed specifically for tennis are recommended.

Lockers

Members may rent lockers with combinations by paying an annual fee of \$44.00 for a full-size locker or \$23.00 for a half-size locker. Locker fees are paid annually by cash, check or credit card. Once locker fees have been paid, they are non-refundable. Guests and non-members may use non-combination lockers on a first-come/first-serve basis at no charge. GMTC is not responsible for any personal belongings that are either lost or stolen.

Nursery

Infants and children may be cared for in the nursery providing the member, non-member or guest is on-site and involved in a MCTC activity. There is a nominal charge for each child. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. To avoid a charge, cancellations must be made at least 2 hours prior to the scheduled reservation. Children may not be brought to the nursery when they are ill. Children are not permitted to wander the tennis center or be disruptive to the center's operation.

Guests

Guests are always welcome at the Greater Midland Tennis Center! Prevailing guest court rates apply to programs and court rentals. There is no limit to the number of times a guest may play in programs and court rentals, but membership is required for league and permanent court participation.

Liability/Waiver of Claims

All members (including those who are parents or guardians of family members under the age of majority and junior members), non-members and guests expressly agree that use of GMTC facilities, equipment and services shall be undertaken at his/her sole risk. GMTC shall not be liable for any injuries or any damage to any member, guest or non-member, or be subject to any claim, right of claim, demand, injury or damages whatsoever. The member, non-member or guest, for himself or herself, and on behalf of his or her executors, administrators and assigns, does hereby expressly and forever release, discharge, and indemnify GMTC, its operating board and assigns, employees, officers and/or agents, for all claims, right of claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions or causes of action arising out of or in connection with the use of GMTC facilities, equipment or services. These policies and terms supersede and replace any and all prior written, spoken and/or implied policies. GMTC reserves the right to amend or discontinue any of the policies and terms in this current statement at any time.
