TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

We're excited to have you join us for the MHSAA Division I Girls' Tennis Finals. The following information has been provided to help make your visit here a smooth one – please take a few minutes to read it, and enjoy the tournament!

PARKING – There is plenty of parking available in the tennis center's main parking lot and in the tournament overflow parking lot across Wackerly Street. All school buses must park in the tournament overflow parking lot. Any unattended parked cars that block fire hydrants, driveways or other cars will be towed at the owner's expense.

TEAM TENTS & TAILGATE AREAS – Weather permitting, team vans and vehicles used for tailgating purposes can be parked on the east or west side of the outdoor complex. Team tents can also be set-up in these areas, but teams are encouraged NOT to set up outdoor tents until Friday morning as there is no outdoor security. The tennis center is not responsible for items left outside unattended. Team tents may not be set-up on the middle cement walkway of the outdoor complex.

USE OF INDOOR SPACE – Starting Friday morning teams are welcome to use indoor space for gathering. The tennis center will open at 6:30 a.m. on Friday. At that time teams are welcome to choose a small team area indoors, but please keep in mind that due to the number of teams and spectators attending the tournament, space will be limited. Additional tables and chairs cannot be brought indoors, and teams may be asked to remove larger coolers and other items if walkways become blocked.

Teams need to supply their own practice balls. Tennis center ball hoppers and teaching carts are not available for tournament use. Additionally, personal stringing machines are not allowed inside the tennis center or in the outdoor complex. Professional racquet stringing is available in the pro shop.

Animals are not allowed inside the facility or on the middle cement walkway of the outdoor complex.

VIDEO POLICY

There is no videotaping or recording of any tennis matched on the Greater Midland Premises. This includes all tournaments using our facility.

The Midland Community Tennis Center is a smoke-free property.

Please help us keep the facility clean and uncluttered by utilizing the trash bins throughout the day.

Tournament Desk – Back of main building, near doors to outdoor courts

Advantage Pro Shop – Lower level of main building, near main entrance is a full service shop with stringing, racquets, shoes, clothing and accessories. PLEASE NOTE that personal stringing machines are not allowed inside the tennis center or in the outdoor complex.

Locker Rooms – Lower level of main building

Bathrooms – In locker rooms, upper level of main building (behind kitchen), and first floor of west wing

Water Fountains – Indoors near kitchen, on lower level of main building (south end) and behind Courts 3, 9 and 13, and outdoors on the middle walkway.

Ice Machine – Upper level of main building near doors to outdoor courts. For water bottles and injury treatment only (please do not use this machine to fill coolers and other large containers as it does not have the capacity to generate that much ice).

Concessions – Kitchen area of main building. Open at 7am on Friday, 8am on Saturday.

Prepared food may be brought into the tennis center in reasonable quantities. NO COOKING OF ANY KIND ON TENNIS CENTER PROPERTY – NO GRILLS, CROCK POTS, HOT PLATES, ETC.

Outdoor courts – Straight through main lobby to back of building

Towels – Towels are available at Welcome Center for a \$1.00 usage fee.

Trainer – there will be a trainer on site by 8 am Friday and Saturday and will be available until the end of play each day.

There will be hundreds of players and spectators for the tournament. Please do not leave personal items unattended. We are not responsible for lost items.
