USCAL Leadership Initiative Team (LIT) Member Requirements

(as revised on 28th March 2016)

USCAL Leadership Initiative Team (LIT) is an executive-level team who will serve closely with the National and Associate Convenor(s). The LIT is not intended to be a static entity that only advises but a proactive team that, collaboratively with the convenors, *initiates strategies and catalyzes national action in the USCAL movement*, as defined in the 4 “R” Vision.

Therefore, LIT members, based on their individual assignment and passion, should:

1. Participate on a team that comprises one of the 4 “R” Vision components, which are Restoration, Reconciliation, Revival and Reformation, and collaborate alongside members of the National Council

LIT members should also:

2. Plan to attend the annual ICAL Congress, a gathering usually held every November in Dallas, TX
3. Plan to attend the annual USCAL National Council meeting, a gathering usually held every June
4. Be willing to host or co-host a USCAL event, such as a Summit or Conference, once every year
5. Participate in several conference calls annually, usually scheduled as necessary
6. Be proactive in recruiting other potential members into USCAL

LIT members would have also already been qualified as:

7. A leader in the church or marketplace and have regional and/or national influence
8. A member of USCAL
