RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Competitors must compete under the following rules and regulations and the VAS Ltd Horse Exhibitor Handbook.
- 2. The Saddlehorse Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving reasons for so doing.
- 3. Stallions are not eligible to compete in any class.
- 4. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A 2023 HEIGHT CERTIFICATE. (Certificates dated 09/01/2023 or later & the most recently dated height certificate must be used please send copy to info@vicagshows.com.au). Those without current certificates <u>MUST</u> be measured at the championships. Either Melbourne Royal or EV or Show Horse Council Victoria height certificates accepted. Horses may be measured on the morning of the Saddle Horse Championships, this will allow for transfer of classes if necessary. In the event of a protest or at the request of a judge, the disputes committee may request that an exhibit be re-measured on the day.
- 5. MEASURING TIMES: Friday 4pm 7pm, Saturday 7am 10am, Sunday 7am 10am.
- 6. NECK NUMBERS: Competitors to supply their own neck number holder. VAS Ltd will supply numbers to be collected at the horse office on arrival. No horse names to be on breast plates.
- 7. **EXHIBITS PER RIDER:** There will be no restriction on the number of horses ridden by the one rider in the Preliminary Judging of all classes. In all championship final classes there must be one rider per mount.
- 8. AGE RESTRICTIONS: The only age restrictions refer to riders in their specific riding class <u>AND</u> the exhibition of Child's Mounts, Leading Rein Classes (3 years & under 8 years) and First Ridden Pony (under 12 years). For Leading Rein Classes, First Ridden Pony and Riding classes' proof of age is required for those under 18 years of age. A Copy of the birth certificate must be received at time of entry via email. Age is taken on the first day of VAS Ltd Show (Saturday 6th January 2024).
- QUALIFICATIONS / PERFORMANCES / ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All sections (Except Led classes, Amateur Owner Rider, Child's Mounts, Rising Star, Leading Rein, First Ridden and Debutante Classes) require qualifications gained between 01/01/20203 and 10/12/2023. Shows after these dates will be qualifiers for 2025 VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.

Refer to each event for qualifying regulations or refer to the qualification requirements listing. Where an agricultural show runs a second horse event, qualifications from this day will not be accepted – only performances from their primary show day.

Qualifications to be gained at financial VAS Ltd Affiliated Agricultural Shows <u>ONLY</u>. For a full list of affiliated VAS Ltd Agricultural Shows, please visit VAS Ltd website at <u>www.vicagshows.com.au</u> or contact the office on (03) 5441 5555.

- 10. DRESS: As per VAS Ltd / EA regulations, current Australian, European or American Standard approved helmets must be worn by all riders of any age whilst competing and exercising. The retaining harness must be secured at all times. Riding coat, collar and tie, stock & pin. Top boots or gaiters are only permitted in riding classes for riders 18 years and over. No logos, identification or emblems to be on riding jackets or attire.
- 11. DRUG TESTING: VAS Ltd may make or cause to be made any test of any exhibit to determine whether any drug or stimulant has been administered to the exhibit as per the VAS Ltd Drug Testing Policy. The exhibit, the exhibitor, the owner of the exhibit and any other person who VAS Ltd deems to be in charge of the exhibit, will be liable to a penalty. The penalty is outlined in the general rules and regulations. A full copy of regulations is available from the VAS Ltd office and website. A levy of \$10 per exhibitor is required.
- 12. **SADDLERY:** Ordinary Snaffle for First Season (with or without dropped noseband/Hanoverian). Simple double bridle or ordinary pelham optional for all other classes. For all classes whip size must be no larger than 75cm tip to tail.
- PROTESTS/COMPLAINTS: Only accepted in writing and received by VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Committee within 24 hours of the event to which the protest relates. A fee of \$100.00 (receipt will be issued) must accompany the protest/complaint and if upheld shall be refunded.
- 14. HORSE LUNGING AREA: No lunging on the main arena except in designated work area prior to 7.30am. There is to be no riding in the judging rings at any time other than scheduled class times.


- 15. **DOGS ON THE GROUNDS**: Dogs on the Bendigo Showgrounds must be restrained at all times. No dogs are allowed in the buildings or on the competition arena. Unrestrained dogs will be impounded by the City Council Ranger.
- 16. **REFUNDS:** may be considered if an acceptable Medical or Veterinary certificate is supplied by 22nd December 2023. Other requests after this date will be considered by the committee. A \$25.00 administration fee will apply.
- 17. INCORRECT ENTRY FORMS: An administration fee of \$25.00 will be imposed on any incorrect entry form.
- 18. ENTRY FEES: All entries must be paid for in full or else the exhibit/exhibitor cannot compete. Outstanding or unpaid entry fees from previous VAS Ltd shows do not allow an exhibitor to enter until they are settled.
- 19. HORSE OFFICE OPEN TIMES: Friday 3pm 7pm, Saturday 7am 6pm, Sunday 7am until show closure.
- 20. **STRAW COLLECTION:** Friday 3pm 6pm, Saturday contact Horse Office, Sunday contact Horse Office. Competitors arriving outside these times need to provide their own straw.
- 21. **UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR:** All persons causing annoyance by loud comments on the decisions of the Judges or by other unseemly as insulting behavior will after being cautioned by a member of the Committee, a Steward, a Judge or the Secretary be expelled from the Show and if an exhibitor may have his/her exhibit disqualified.
- 22. HEAT POLICY: In the event of adverse heat, weather adjustments will be made to the timetable as per the VAS Ltd Heat Policy and all endeavors to notify exhibitors. Please refer to the VAS Facebook page and website for updates.
- 23. **SENORY HAIRS**: A Horse's sensory hairs may not be clipped and/or shaven or otherwise modified in any way under penalty of elimination from the event. Individual sensory hairs may be removed by a veterinarian to prevent pain or discomfort for the Horse. Areas of hair that must be clipped, shaven or removed to allow veterinary treatment are exempt from this rule.

1 Champion or 2 Reserve Champions, or 2 Open Class wins at a VAS Ltd Agricultural Show between 1/1/2023 – 10/12/2023

Off The Track (Ridden & Led):

Must have qualified in the 2023 Calendar Year at a VAS Ltd Affiliated Show in the Off The Track Qualifying Show Level event.

Good Hands:
