

Big Bad
wool



oshare
the love...

finished measurements: approximately 30" x 33"

gauge: 17 sts and 24 rows per 4 inches in stockinette stitch with weepaca only.

yarn: 7 weepaca by Big Bad Wool - [50% fine washable merino / 50% baby alpaca; 95 yds / 86 m]
1 Oshare Pon Pon by Mondo Fil - [55% acrylic / 45% nylon; 710 yds]

tools: size 9 (5.5mm) 32" circular needle, size H crochet hook or size to obtain desired gauge.

getting started

Cast on 140 stitches. [For a built-in knit border (not shown), cast on 150 stitches. Knit first 10 rows & last 10 rows while knitting the first 5 stitches & last 5 stitches of each row. Tip: Place a marker after 5 stitches worked and another marker after 145 stitches worked, with 140 stitches between the markers. Omit crochet border.]

Hold one strand of each yarn and work in stockinette stitch 20 rows. (knit 1 row, purl 1 row)
Cut Oshare. Ready to work a right side row, work in stockinette stitch 20 rows.

Work last 40 rows 3 times. (160 rows)

Ready to work a right side row, hold one strand of each yarn and work in stockinette stitch 20 rows. Bind off.

crochet edge

Round 1: *single crochet, chain 1, skip 1 stitch; repeat to end. Work 3 times in each corner.
Round 2: *slip stitch in each chain space & single crochet. Work 3 times in each corner.
Fasten off.



For best results, wet block with Eucalan, a rinse-less wool wash. Sew on the 'handmade' tag so everyone will know.
