

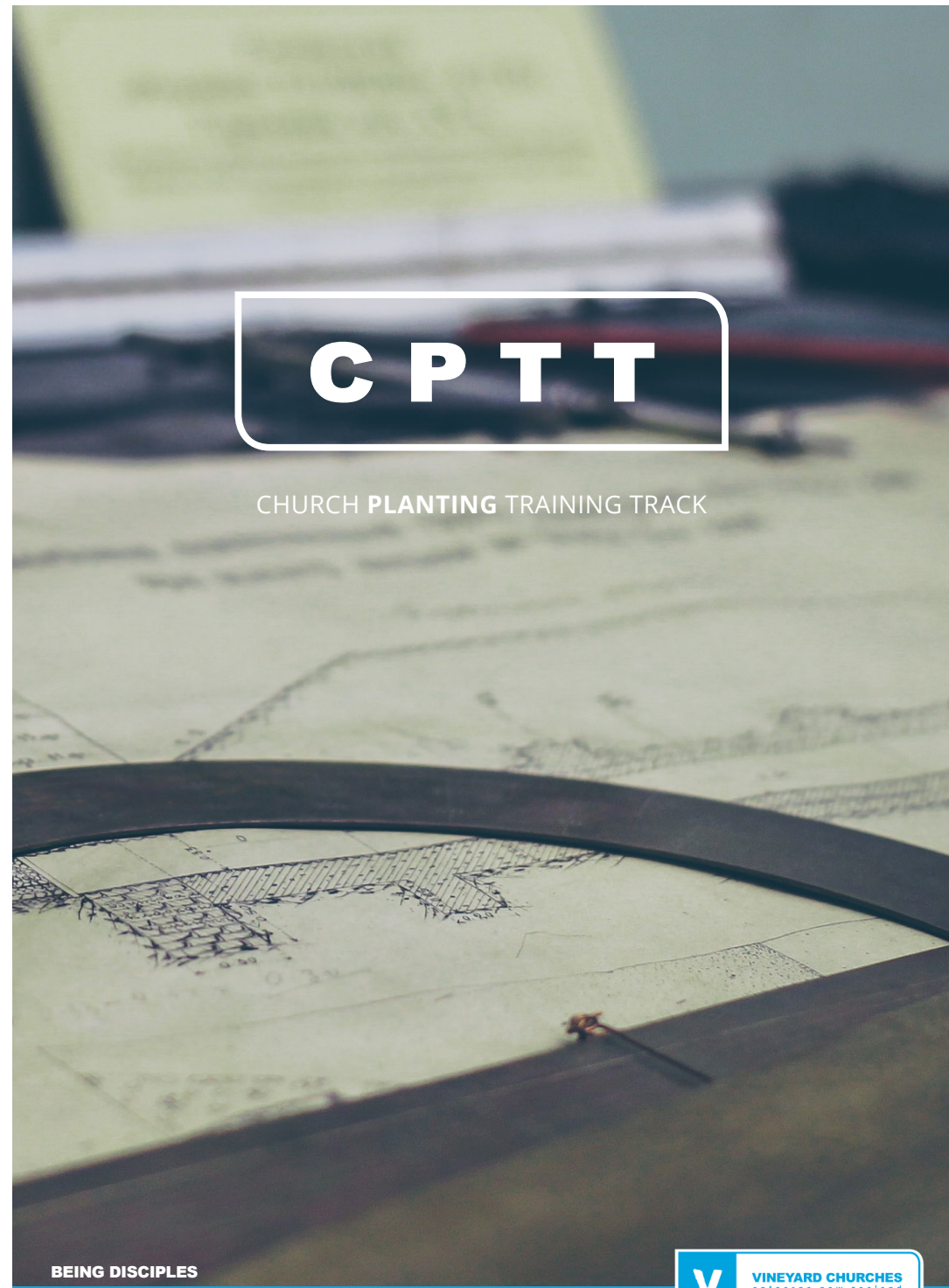

WHO CAN DO CPTT?

Potential church planters must first get through a selection process. If you feel called to plant a Vineyard church, please apply to start this process.

CPTT is also ideal for potential church planters to be able to bring possible members of their planting team to the intensives with them.

HOW DOES CPTT WORK?

LEADERSHIP INTENSIVES

CPTT participants will join others doing Vineyard leadership training in two intensives which involve lectures by pastors, leaders and trainers who are effective practitioners in their fields.

First Intensive: Wellington 8-9 April, 2016

Second Intensive: Stratford 2-3 September 2016

LEARNING COMMUNITY

CPTT participants will join the online Vineyard Training Learning Community, reading a variety of books over the year and engaging with them alongside other members of our Learning Community.

There will also be available for you a wide range of resources in MP3, video and readings on all things related to church planting and church leadership.

COACHING

Monthly coaching will continue after you have planted so that you can partner with and benefit from the resources of the wider Vineyard movement in establishing your new church.
